On the above listed date and time Special Agent William Conn conducted an interview with Tanner Hess regarding the Officer Involved Critical Incident.

S/A Conn asked Mr. Hess to explain what he observed happening on the evening of August 5, 2023 as it related to the OIC. Mr. Hess stated that he awoke from a nap at approximately 1830 hrs and exited his residence. Mr. Hess residence is directly west of the the decedent residence 205 US RT 250 (OIC scene). The decedent was Mr. Hess's uncle. Mr. Hess states he saw his mother Carol Hess talking to the decedent in the backyard of the decedent residence (OIC scene). Mr. Hess then states he walked to his mother's residence 215 US RT 250, which is S/W of his residence and the OIC scene to visit with his mother and father. Upon his mother's return to her residence Mr. Hess states that his mother stated that his uncle was very upset, appeared intoxicated and was waving a gun around and that she had called the police. Mr. Hess states that he saw the deputies arrive and walk toward the rear of his uncle's residence. Mr. Hess states he lost sight of the deputies and a very short time later he heard what sounded like
