Narrative:

On Tuesday, December 20, 2022, the Marion County Sheriff's Office and Marion Police Department requested the assistance of the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) with the investigation of an Officer Involved Critical Incident which occurred in LaRue, Marion County, Ohio. During the investigation, Agents obtained records from the Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission (OPOTC) for Commission (OPOTC).
