**Narrative:**

On December 20, 2022, Special Agent (SA) David Horn (Horn) interviewed Deputy Jess Allen (Allen) from the Marion County Sheriff's Department. The interview was regarding the officer-involved shooting (OIS) that occurred on the morning of December 20, 2022, along the railroad tracks near North Section Street in LaRue, Ohio. The interview was conducted at the Marion Police Department located at 233 West Center Street, Marion, Ohio.

The interview began at 1100 hours on December 20, 2022. SA Horn explained the reason for the interview to Allen, and Allen agreed to continue to speak with SA Horn. Allen provided his date of birth as January 2, 1994.

Allen advised that he was assigned as a drone operator and was far from the incident. SA Horn watched the incident of the shooting. Allen made a copy of the footage, provided it to BCI, and was advised to keep the original.

At that time, the interview was concluded at 1120 hrs.

This report only summarizes the information deemed by the author to be of the most relevance to the investigation and does not purport to contain all questions and answers from the interview. Further, this report was placed in a chronology to aid the reader's overall understanding of the information elicited during the interview and may not be reflective of the actual sequencing of questions. It is suggested that the full recording be reviewed to clarify any content or contextual questions regarding the information from the interview.
