## **Narrative:**

On Monday, December 26, 2022, at about 1202 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chuck Moran (Moran) received a USB thumb drive from Barberton Police Department (BPD) Detective (Det.) Tony Memmer (Memmer). The USB thumb drive contained copies of surveillance video from the YMCA located at 500 West Hopocan Avenue, Barberton, Ohio 44203.

SA Moran checked the USB thumb drive and noted there were three video files on it. The video files were:

- North Lot\_20221226\_085531
- Front Lot 3 20221226 085721
- 24 7 Door 1 20221226 090548

SA Moran, SA Nick Valente (Valente) and SA Todd Clark (Clark) reviewed the three video files on the USB thumb drive and noted that the videos received did not capture the entire incident as agents previously observed on the video surveillance system at the YMCA. SA Valente and SA Clark made arrangements with the YMCA to obtain a full copy of the surveillance videos.
