Narrative:

On Saturday, November 16, 2019, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Eric Lehnhart received a text message from Chris Blunk (Captain Blunk), Jail Administrator and Captain, at the Richland County Jail.

According to Captain Blunk, an unidentified Ohio Labor Council, Inc. (OLC) Union Steward advised him "that their officers involved will not make any statement without Garrity."

Captain Blunk stated that he will not compel his employees to sit for an interview, as this investigation is a criminal matter. As such, no interviews were conducted with Richland County correctional officers involved in this incident.
