JUDGMENT ENTRY

This cause came on for hearing on July 1, 1985, upon application of the plaintiff for judgment by default, defendants having failed to answer or otherwise defend. This court has jurisdiction over the defendants pursuant to the consent order concerning permanent injunctive relief entered into on June 28, 1984.
