<i>The Jurors of the Grand Jury of the State of Ohio, within and for the body of the County aforesaid, on their oaths, IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF Ohio, do find and present, that the above named Defendant(s), on or about the date of the offense set forth above, in the County of Allen, State of Ohio, unlawfully</i>	
did promise, offer, or give him or another person any valuable thing or valuable benefit, to wit: offered to pay fees to reinstate the witness' driver's license and employment at one of the Schroeder businesses, with purpose to corrupt a witness or improperly to influence him with respect to his testimony in an official proceeding, either before or after he was subpoenaed or sworn.	
To wit: On or about January 12, 2026, Brady Schroeder did offer a job and payment of debts on a driver's license to Gregory Lambert, in exchange for specific testimony by Gregory Lambert at a trial which was at that time docketed for February 25, 2026, in Paulding County.	
<i>The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.</i>



Revised Code 2923.13 states that:

No person shall knowingly acquire, have, carry or use any firearm or dangerous ordnance if such person is under indictment for any felony of violence, or any felony offense involving the illegal possession, use, sale, administration, distribution, or trafficking in any drug of abuse.

Revised Code 2937.99 states that:

(A) No person shall fail to appear as required, after having been released pursuant to section 2937.29 of the Revised Code. Whoever violates this section is guilty of failure to appear and shall be punished as set forth in division (B) or (C) of this section. (B) If the release was in connection with a felony charge or pending appeal after conviction of a felony, failure to appear is a felony of the fourth degree. (C) If the release was in connection with a misdemeanor charge or for appearance as a witness, failure to appear is a misdemeanor of the first degree.
