Seeking Assistance with Locating a Vehicle

The Ohio Attorney General's Bureau of Criminal Investigation and Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation are seeking assistance to help locate a light colored 2004 Chevrolet Tahoe. This vehicle is wanted in connection to a felony crime committed in Creek County, Oklahoma in September of 2017. Robert Emerson Firethunder is under arrest in connection to an incident that led to the death of his cousin, Nicholas Ray Martinez. After the incident, Firethunder drove the below pictured vehicle to Ohio, specifically the Shreve (Wayne County) and Mansfield (Richland County) areas, where he exchanged this vehicle for one belonging to an area relative. Both Robert Firethunder and a juvenile companion were apprehended in Daytona Beach, Florida.
