



- A. Pursuant to R.C. 3704.06, Defendants are ordered to pay a total civil penalty of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) for the violations described in Count One of the State's Complaint.
- B. Pursuant to R.C. 1509.33, Defendants are ordered to pay a total civil penalty of one hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$190,000.00) for the violations described in Counts Two, Three, Four, Five, and Six of the State's Complaint.
- C. Defendants shall make all payments described in Paragraphs A and B of this Order through cashier's or certified checks or money orders, payable to the order of "Treasurer, State of Ohio," and delivered to the State of Ohio, c/o Sandra Finan, Paralegal, or her successor at the Office of the Attorney General of Ohio, Environmental Enforcement Section, 30 East Broad Street, 25<sup>th</sup> Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
- D. Defendants are ordered to pay all Cost.
- E. This Court's Judgment Entry, journalized December 10, 2019 and time-stamped December 10, 2019, shall remain effective and enforceable against Defendants.

The Court will retain jurisdiction of this suit for the purpose of making any order or decree that it may deem necessary at any time to carry out its judgment.


