Awareness Subcommittee

- No update on awareness campaign. K. Warren is lead.



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Justice Subcommittee / Policy Subcommittee

- Ohio Criminal Justice Services (OCJS) has approved the production of law enforcement tip cards. OCJS has budgeted \$2,000 to produce the cards. Current estimates are \$200 per 10,000 cards printed (black and white, 9 x 4 size, heavy cardstock). Initially, cards will be distributed to major law enforcement organizations and the groups/agencies represented on the Commission. Target date is September 14, 2010, the kick off of the Attorney General's Law Enforcement Conference. O. Corbin is lead on card production.
- A compilation of statewide resources, organized by county, is complete. Determining how resources will be regularly updated is the next step. B. Laubert and C. Haenszel are leads.
- Draft language to be added to the Ohio Law Enforcement Gateway (OHLEG) was not available for review. Language will build upon law enforcement tip card with the addition of references to criminal offenses that can be charged in elder abuse cases. R. Hornbostel is the lead.

Research Subcommittee

- Deferred until "new business" on the agenda.

Legislative Draft

- Completed review of Legislative Service Commission (LSC) draft that was distributed and initially reviewed during April 26, 2010 Commission meeting. Changes proposed to the Adult Protective Services Law (ORC. 5101.60) in H.B. 563 (126th Ohio General Assembly) is the framework of the draft.

NEW BUSINESS – Commission

- Discussed the purpose and format of the research event. There was consensus to seek permission from the Supreme Court of Ohio and Ohio Association of Probate Judges to link the event with the Ohio Summit on Aging scheduled October 15, 2010.
