OPOTA'S | MOBILE ACADEMY

The Attorney General's Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (OPOTA) has revolutionized its approach to advanced training. With state-of-the-art equipment and expert instructors, OPOTA's Mobile Academy takes training directly to local law enforcement. Most courses are available at no cost to local agencies.

Mobile Academy Offerings

- **Advanced Building Clearing (ABC):** OPOTA offers agencies a portable training facility to practice scenarios related to room entry and building clearing. The temporary structure can be quickly set up in limitless configurations and offers many variations with room sizes, inward/outward-opening doors, hallways, four-way intersections, and target placement. OPOTA's training officers will demonstrate a variety of options, methods, and tactics that emphasize officer safety when clearing an unfamiliar and potentially occupied structure.
- **Judgmental Driving Training:** Seven PatrolSim driving simulators feature programmable dashboards that replicate those of popular cruisers. Instructors use provided scenarios, or build their own, to help officers improve decision-making during traffic stops, pursuits, emergency responses, and vehicle handling. The simulators are housed in comfortable, climate-controlled trailers, allowing instruction to take place near local facilities. Interactive features will be added in 2017.
- **Judgmental Firearms and Use-of-Force Training:** The Mobile Academy's seven MILO Range Pro simulators can be set up in minutes within local facilities. They feature more than 425 scenarios, scenario-authoring software, and a library of firearms drills and exercises.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

ADDITIONAL TRAINING OPTIONS

- **eOPOTA:** More than 90 courses are offered through this Web-based training option, which is available free of charge and around the clock. Through eOPOTA, agencies can eliminate travel costs and accommodate busy department schedules.
- **Interactive Training:** Hundreds of courses are available at OPOTA's main campus and tactical training center in London, Ohio, and a satellite campus in Richfield, Ohio. The London campus features a 1.8-mile driving track, indoor and outdoor firing ranges, a scenario house for realistic training exercises, a gymnasium, double rooms for overnight stays, and a fitness center.
- **Law Enforcement Conference:** Each fall, 30 workshops are offered at this educational conference. The event draws several hundred attendees and provides valuable networking opportunities.
- **Regional Courses:** In an effort to reduce the burden of sending officers far for training, OPOTA offers many interactive trainings at regional sites throughout the state.
- **Webcast Courses:** To provide interactive, live, instructor-led training to officers, OPOTA offers several courses via GoToWebcast. Officers can participate in training via computers, iPads, or other electronic mobile devices without travel time and associated costs. All students have the ability to ask questions, participate in surveys, and view class materials.
