

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing will be held by the Office of Ohio Attorney General Michael DeWine on **November 30, 2012 at 1:00 PM in the B1 Hearing Room of the Rhodes State Office Tower, located at 30 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.**

The purpose of the hearing is to solicit public comment on proposed amendments to the following rules:

### O.A.C. 109:6-1-01

This rule contains the definitions for the background investigation rules. The proposed amendments to Rule 109:6-1-01 eliminate the annual update definition, add a new triennial update definition, add a new compliance schedule definition, and amend the definition of applicant to be consistent with recent legislation.

### O.A.C. 109:6-1-02

This rule establishes (1) who must submit a disclosure statement to the Attorney General, (2) when the statements must be submitted, and (3) the contents of the statements. The proposed amendments eliminate annual update requirements and outline new triennial update requirements that are consistent with recent statutory amendments.

### O.A.C. 109:6-1-04

This rule sets the fee schedule for background investigations of off-site waste facilities. The proposed rule will be amended to change annual investigative fees to triennial investigative fees. The rule will also be amended to include a retained applicant fingerprint database fees consistent with the requirements of newly enacted legislation.

All interested parties are invited to attend the hearing and present oral and/or written testimony. Written comments may also be submitted prior to the hearing to the attention of Patricia Payne, Environmental Community Liaison, Environmental Enforcement, Office of the Attorney General, at 30 East Broad Street, 25<sup>th</sup> Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3400, no later than November 29, 2012.
