Narrative:

On 08/25/2023, Special Agent (SA) Tiffany Najmulski (Najmulski) went to the Celina Fire Department to meet with Fireman/Paramedic Aaron Beougher (Beougher). Beougher was dispatched to the scene of the officer involved shooting at Eastview Park in Celina. The following is a summary of the interview which was digitally recorded and attached to the case file.

Beougher advised he was dispatched to shots fired, but originally put on standby. Eventually, medics were told to go to the park for a gun shot victim. When medics arrived, the police officers moved their vehicles so the ambulance could get closer. Beougher saw officers were holding pressure to the patient's back. Medics applied a chest seal and did an assessment. The patient did not appear to be breathing, nor his heart beating, so they started CPR.

The patient was loaded on the ambulance and was treated for cardiac arrest. Beougher saw wounds on the left leg where a tourniquet had been applied. Beougher said he noticed three bullet wounds.

Beougher said he did not hear any of the officers talking about the incident and did not see anything at the scene that seemed suspicious. Beougher had nothing else to add and the interview concluded.

This report only summarizes the information deemed by the author to be of the most relevance to the investigation and does not purport to contain all questions and answers from the audio recording. Further, this report was placed in a chronology to aid the reader's overall understanding of the information elicited during the interview and may not be reflective of the actual sequencing of questions or responses. It is suggested that the full audio recording be reviewed to clarify any content or contextual questions regarding the information from the
