On 12/28/2022 at 0916 hours, S/A Hammond removed the clothing items from drying cabinet #3. The bags were secure and in the same condition as when they were originally placed. The contents of the three bags were placed onto new, clean, Kraft paper. The items were examined for evidence and photographed. Personal protection equipment was utilized during the examination. The items were photographed as they were found. The bags contained items that were collected from the Travis Hellinger at the hospital and provided to S/A Hammond by S/A C. Holcomb.

Bag #1 contained: a neoprene holster with clip (item #36), a wallet (Ohio OL, bank cards, \$20.00), tobacco pouch, 2 sets of keys and receipts (item 37). It also contained a tourniquet (item 38) and smart watch (item 39). A pair of blue work pants with belt and underwear were also located in bag #1 (item 40).

Bag #2 contained: one pair of work boots and black socks (item 41).

Bag #3 contained: a black Puma Hoodie, blue shirt with logo and black shirt (item 42). It also contained a black neoprene shoulder holster (item 43).

Items were repackaged into new clean, brown bags and manila envelopes. The items were placed into temporary locker #3 at 1125 hours. Digital images from the scene were uploaded to the Matrix system. The items will be placed into the non-drug evidence room.
