

A public hearing will be held by the Office of Attorney General Mike DeWine on Friday, April 6th, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. in the Lobby Hearing Room of the Rhodes State Office Tower, located at 30 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

The purpose of the hearing is to solicit comment on the following proposed amended rule:

109:1-1-08 Notice of revocation of ~~501(e)(3)~~ federal taxation exemption.

Any charitable trust which is required to register with the attorney general and is no longer exempt from federal taxation ~~pursuant to Section 501(e)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code,~~ must notify the attorney general's charitable law section immediately upon receipt of notice of the revocation. The notification to the attorney general shall include a copy of the revocation letter issued by the internal revenue service, which shall be made a public record.

All interested parties are invited to attend the hearing and present oral and/or written testimony.
