- Ear and **Impact Resistant** and Wrap Around Eye Protection is Mandatory.
- Clothing Suitable For the Range and Classroom and for all weather conditions. (Remember I was born in Great Britain, so it will rain for me regardless of season, location or the time of year!!!!)

### Firearms: Full-Automatic or Semi-Automatic.

- H&K MP5, MP7, UMP, 53, 33, G36 or 416.
- Colt SMG, M4 or M16 A1/A2 Rifle.
- ANY M4 All Brands.
- Sig Sauer. LWRC. S&W & ANY Other SMG/Rifle: 9mm - .223'.
- Sling.
- 2 x 30 round or 3 x 20 round magazines per attendees.
- Hand gun and holster per attendee.

**(The Certificate will qualify all attendees for both the H&K & M4/AR15. All attendees will be encouraged to familiarise themselves with both.)**

### Ammunition:

- 1,200 rounds **TOTAL** of good factory manufactured ammunition.  
(Note: If attending with more than one weapon system the total ammo count is still 1,200. Decide how many rounds from each weapon you want to fire!!)  
(I do not recommend cheap re-loads, military surplus or aluminum case ammo)


