Investigative Activity: Documentation of Involved Officers (Scene #2)

Activity Date: February 11, 2022

Activity Location: Columbus Police SWAT Headquarters

On February 11, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chad Holcomb was assigned to assist the Columbus Police Department (CPD) with an officer involved critical incident. It was reported that CPD SWAT was attempting to arrest Bret Andrews (Andrews) with an outstanding warrant in the Home Depot parking lot in Grove City, Ohio. As SWAT approached the vehicle, it was reported that Andrews brandished a firearm. Three CPD SWAT members discharged their firearms. Andrews was later pronounced deceased at the hospital.

SA Holcomb responded to the CPD SWAT Headquarters to document the involved officers at 2323 hours. SA Holcomb was informed that two SWAT officers, Ofc. Cibulskas and Ofc. Shope did not discharge their weapons during the incident. They were photographed as they were upon arrival. Their firearms were documented through photography and a cartridge count was performed. Both officer's firearms were fully loaded.

SA Holcomb met with SWAT Officers who discharged their firearms. Ofc. Liford, Ofc. Ashenhurst and Ofc. Cutshall were all photographed as they were upon arrival. They all had markings on their uniform and ballistic vest identifying them as law enforcement.

No additional items of evidentiary value were collected. Documentation of the involved officers was completed at 2353.
