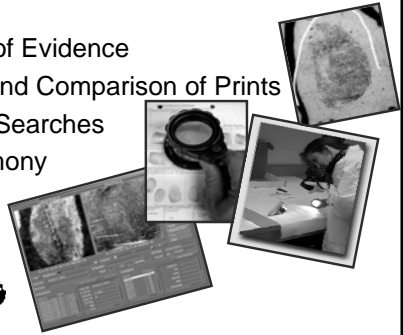

- Biographical data to assist in locating a criminal record



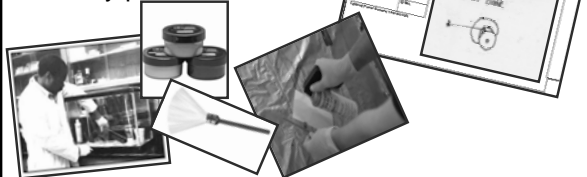
Latent Print Evidence

Remove items not necessary for processing



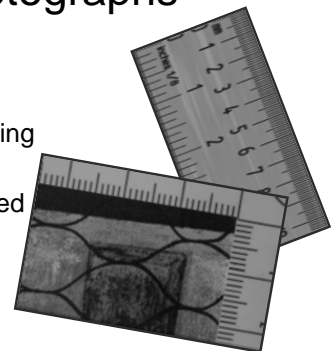
Latent Print Evidence

- Latent lifts that are labeled with location of collection
- Label second, third etc. lifts
- List any processes used



Photographs

- Photos **must** include a measuring device
- Digital photos need to be in .TIF or RAW format
