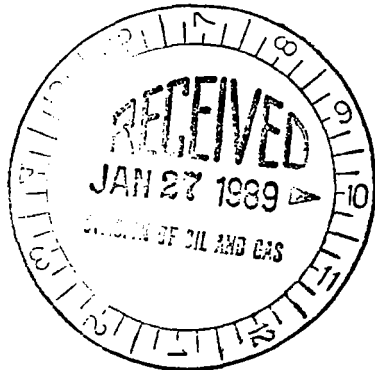

ENTRY

The Court being advised of the premises herein hereby finds that the defendant has been served summons and the complaint in this matter but has failed to answer or otherwise defend as required by the Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure.

The Court further finds that the defendant is subject to but is not in compliance with R.C. 1509 as set forth in the complaint.

It is therefore ADJUDGED, ORDERED and DECREED that the defendant and its officers are enjoined from further oil and gas well operations in the State of Ohio until they comply with the requirements of R.C. 1509. Further, the defendant shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for the violations of law set forth in the complaint. Payment shall be made by delivering to the Fiscal Section, Division of Oil and Gas, Fountain Square, Building A, Columbus, Ohio 43224, a certified check in the stated amount made

March 1, 1989.


