FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On May 11, 2009, the Director of the Ohio EPA ("Director") issued a Proposed Order proposing to revoke Flovest Inc.'s National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. 1PZ00007*AD

2. On June 9, 2009, the Ohio EPA received a request for an adjudication hearing from Flovest, Inc., in response to the issuance of the May 11, 2009 proposed revocation of the NPDES permit.

3. On February 10, 2011, this Hearing Officer filed a "Notice of Failures to Comply with Orders" and "Notice of Intent to Dismiss Respondent" in this case.

4. No objection to the Notice of Intent to Dismiss was filed in this matter.

5. On March 16, 2011, this Hearing Officer filed an "Order Dismissing Respondent" as a party to this case.

6. No objection or other response to the Order Dismissing Respondent has been filed in this matter.

7. No adjudication hearing has been held in this matter.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Because Flovest, Inc. has been dismissed from this case, and because no party is left to participate in an adjudication hearing and prosecute a claim that the Director's May 11, 2009 Proposed Order proposing to revoke Flovest Inc.'s National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. 1PZ00007*AD should not be issued as a final order, the Director should dismiss Ohio EPA Case No. 09-WD-026.

2. Because Flovest, Inc. has been dismissed from this case, and because no party is left to participate in an adjudication hearing and prosecute a claim that the Director's May 11, 2009 Proposed Order proposing to revoke Flovest Inc.'s National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. 1PZ00007*AD should not be issued as a final order, the Director should issue the May 11, 2009 Proposed Order as a Final Order.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. The Director should dismiss Ohio EPA Case No. 09-WD-026.

2. The Director should issue the May 11, 2009 Proposed Order proposing to revoke Flovest Inc.'s National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. 1PZ00007*AD as a Final Order.
