CONSENT ORDER

The Preliminary Injunction in Case No. 81607, having been filed on March 8, 1988 and the Contempt Order in Case No. 81607, having been filed on August 22, 1989, and Plaintiff State of Ohio by its Attorney General, Anthony J. Celebreeze, Jr. (hereinafter "Plaintiff"), Group Maintenance, Inc. (hereinafter "GMI"), an intervenor party to this litigation as granted on December 13, 1988 for the sole purpose of this Consent Order, and Defendant Gasoil, Inc., stipulating to an accommodation to achieve abatement of the conditions subject to this lawsuit, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

1. Jurisdiction. This Court has jurisdiction over the parties consenting to this Order and the subject matter of this case pursuant to Chapter 1509 of the Ohio Revised Code.



The provisions of this Consent Order shall apply to and be binding on Defendant Gasoil, Inc. The provisions of this Consent Order will be fully complied with on or before November 15, 1989 or later, if the parties submit a written stipulation extending said date.

2. The parties intend that this Consent Order will facilitate clean-up of the Remelius well site, and specifically that the existing open impoundments will be eliminated so that they will be rendered incapable of accumulating or retaining fluids. Further, the existing contents of the concrete skimmer tank shall be lawfully disposed of. The existing concrete skimmer tank shall remain intact and rendered incapable of accepting fluids by a mutually acceptable means until and unless authorized by permit issued pursuant to R.C. 1509. To that end, it is agreed:

a. Gasoil, Inc. shall provide the excavation machinery and operators required to achieve clean-up of the Remelius injection well site open-air impoundments and concrete skimmer tank at its expense;

b. Gasoil, Inc. shall provide the dump trucks and drivers required to haul the waste material from the impoundments and concrete skimmer tank to an EPA-approved dumpsite in a lawful manner at its expense or dispose of it at its expense in a lawful manner as approved by EPA;

c. The State of Ohio, Department of Natural Resources, shall provide: sampling of sludge and/or soil and supervision services required to achieve clean-up of the open-air impoundments and concrete skimmer tank at the Remelius injection well, at its expense and subject to the provisions of R.C. 126.07;

d. The parties shall undertake to determine the scope of the clean-up of the open-air impoundments and concrete skimmer tank, including an estimate to be provided by the Department of Natural Resources of the amount of material that will have to be removed from the site for disposal;

e. Gasoil, Inc. shall obtain estimates from approved disposal sites for the cost of disposal;

f. Gasoil, Inc. shall pay up to Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) in fees charged at the site of disposal. If these monies are not fully exhausted for the indicated purpose, they shall be expended for site cleanup as the Division directs.

g. Those wells identified in Schedule A, attached hereto and fully incorporated herein by reference, which provide oil or gas for domestic purposes, have always been and shall continue to be operable, regardless of the status of the clean-up of the Remelius facility. All other wells identified in Schedule A may be operated, contingent upon ongoing performance of promises made by Gasoil herein, and while grading and other rehabilitation of the site, to the satisfaction of the Department of Natural Resources, is underway;

h. Gasoil, Inc. shall accept contribution from third parties for the purpose of achieving clean-up and fully expand same, without cost or set-off, in furtherance of the parties' objectives. This shall be subject to monitoring by the State and the Court.

3. Any entity may apply at anytime to the Division of Oil and Gas for transfer of a permit to bring oilfield waste on-site and operate the Remelius injection well pursuant to R.C. Chapter 1509. No off-site waste shall be brought to the site without written authorization from the Chief of the Division of Oil and Gas.

4. At such time as the State notifies the Court that the Division of Oil and Gas is satisfied that the open-air surface impoundments have been rendered incapable of accumulating or retaining fluids, then this case is dismissed without prejudice.

5. GMI shall file with the Court of Appeals a Motion for Stay of its Appeal within ten (10) days of the filing of the Consent Order.

It is so ORDERED.
