On May 14, 2007, defendant's sentencing hearing was held, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 2929.19. Present in Court were Defense Attorney KRIS BLANTON, and Assistant Attorney General, BRIAN BALL, as was the defendant, who was afforded all rights pursuant to Criminal Rule 32. The Court has considered the record, oral statements, any victim impact statements and the pre-sentence investigation report, as well as the principles and purposes of sentencing under Ohio Revised Code Section 2929.11, and has balanced the seriousness and recidivism factors of Ohio Revised Code Section 2929.12.

The Court finds that the defendant has been convicted of *TRANSPORTING SCRAP TIRES WITHOUT REGISTRATION*, in violation of ORC 3734.83(A), an Unclassified Felony, subject to Section 2929.11 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Therefore, after due consideration, the Court finds that the defendant is amenable to available to Community Control Sanctions.

It is therefore ordered that the defendant be sentenced to ~~Three~~ ⁽³⁾ ~~years~~ of Community Control, subject to the basic supervision and control of the Adult Probation Department, under any terms and conditions that they deem appropriate, including that the defendant shall be prohibited from leaving the State without permission of the Court or the Adult Probation Department. The defendant shall abide by all laws including, but not limited to, the laws related to firearms and dangerous ordinance.

The Court further imposes specific sanctions and conditions as follows:

Violation of any of this sentence shall lead to a more restrictive sanction, a longer sanction, or a stated prison term of Two (2) years. After prison release, if post release control is imposed, for violation of post release control conditions, the Adult Parole Authority or Parole Board could impose a more restrictive or longer control sanction or return the defendant to prison up to a maximum of 1/2 of the stated prison term. If the violation is a new felony, defendant may receive a prison term of the greater of one year or the time remaining on post release control, in addition to any other prison term imposed for the new offense.

Defendant is hereby ordered to report to the Adult Probation Department. Defendant is ordered to pay restitution of \$ 5,000.00, all costs of prosecution, Court Appointed Counsel costs, and any supervision fees permitted pursuant to ORC 2929.18 (A)(4).

THE DEFENDANT SHALL SUBMIT TO DNA TESTING, PURSUANT TO O.R.C. 2901.07.

In accordance with authority conferred by Ohio Law, you have been placed on Community Control this date 05/14/2007 for a period of 3yr by Honorable JUDGE SPENCER sitting in and for this Court at West Union, Ohio.

CONDITIONS OF SUPERVISION

It is the Order of the Court that you shall comply with the following conditions and sanctions:

1. You shall not violate any federal, state, local law, or Court order. You must notify Your Probation Officer by the next business day if arrested, summoned, or cited for any violation or any contact with a law enforcement officer. You shall not associate with persons having a criminal background.
2. You shall not leave the State without permission of the Adams County Probation Department. *EXCLUDED: IN INB., AND WORK PURPOSES*
3. You shall keep your supervising Officer informed of your residence and place of employment and shall obtain permission before changing same.
4. You shall follow all orders, verbal or written, given to you by your supervising Officer or other authorized representatives of the Court. Report on *CALL IN MONTHLY. 15TH OF MONTH.* of each month.
5. You agree, pursuant to Revised Code 2951.02, that authorized Probation Officers may search with or without a warrant, your person, place of residence, motor vehicle or other real or personal property that you occupy or have permission to use, if there are reasonable grounds to believe that you are not complying with the law or conditions of supervision.
6. You will not purchase, possess, own, use, or have under your control, any firearms, ammunition, dangerous ordinance or weapons.
7. You must receive advance written approval of the Chief Probation Officer to work in any undercover capacity for any law enforcement agency.
8. You shall not possess or use any illegal drugs as defined in R.C. 2925.01. You may possess lawfully prescribed drugs issued in your name by a licensed physician, under the following conditions: You shall notify your Probation Officer of any medical, dental, or psychiatric condition which will require treatment. Prior to obtaining or using any mood altering or prescriptive medication, you shall notify the prescribing medical provider of your chemical dependency, your conviction, and all medications you are prescribed or using at the time. You shall request that the provider notify the Probation Officer in writing of the following: 1) that the provider has knowledge of your conviction and chemical dependency; 2) the identity of the drugs prescribed, and 3) the reason for the prescription. You shall promptly provide verification to the Probation Department that such notices were given to the medical providers. You shall submit to random drug screens.
9. You shall obtain all prescriptions through one pharmacy and shall provide the name and address of the pharmacy to the Probation Officer. You shall have one doctor who coordinates your medical care and shall provide the doctor's identity to the Probation Officer.
10. You shall pay the Court Costs in this matter within 18 Mo. and a supervision fee of \$20.00 per month.
11. You must comply with all sanctions or special conditions of Community Control ordered by the Court. The Sanctions in this case are:
Pay Restit. Of 5000.00 W/In 18 Mo.; 240 Hrs. C.S.;

12. You understand and agree that if you are arrested in any other State or Territory of the United States, your signature as witnessed on this form will be a waiver of extradition and that no other formalities will be required for an authorized agent of the State of Ohio to bring your return to this State.

I understand that the Court may change, reduce or extend the period of Community Control, and may issue a warrant for a violation and revoke Community Control or impose additional sanctions, including a stated jail or prison term.

I have read, or had read to me, the above conditions of Community Control. I fully understand them and will abide by them.
