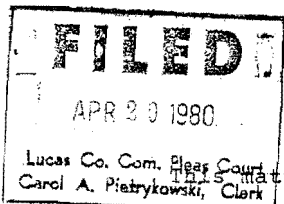

This matter came before this Court on January 28, 1980, on

Plaintiff's Motion for a Preliminary Injunction banning the Defendants from tapping into the Plaintiff's existing sanitary sewage system. After discussing the matter, the Court finds that the parties have come to an agreement to dismiss the matter of the Preliminary Motion and settle the matter of the ultimate request in this case, that is, Permanent Injunctive Relief. The Court further finds that the parties have agreed that the Plaintiff is entitled to a permanent injunction barring the Defendants from tapping into the Plaintiff's existing sanitary sewage system until the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency has approved plans for such tap in from the Maumee Bay State Park, as required under Section 6111.44 of the Ohio Revised Code.


WHEREFORE, it is, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Motion for Preliminary Injunction be dismissed.


It is, further, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Defendants, S. E. Johnson Company and the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, be permanently enjoined from tapping into the Plaintiff's sanitary sewage system from the Maumee Bay State Park until approval is obtained from Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for such tap in, as required by Section 6111.44 of the Ohio Revised Code.
