**ENTRY** 

This matter comes before the Court upon appeal from UCRC (Unemployment Compensation Review Commission) case number H2011/2228.

The Court finds this is an unemployment compensation appeal under Ohio Revised Code Section 4141.282, which provides that a court shall affirm the determination of Ohio Unemployment Compensation Review Commission unless the court finds that the review of the commission's decision was unlawful, unreasonable or against the manifest weight of the evidence. If the court renders such a finding, then it shall reverse, vacate or modify the review commission's determination.

Michael Craft claims that he was wrongfully discharged from his employment with his job with Glockner Chevrolet Company, Inc., Glockner Chevrolet Company, Inc., said that Michael Craft quit his job with them. This Court is not permitted to make factual findings and reach credibility determinations. The appellant has presented this Court with a version of facts projected by the hearing officer.

The hearing officer and the UCRC found the appellant did enter into a kickback scheme involving company vehicles. The hearing officer and UCRC also concluded that appellant's hearing testimony was not credible and appellant had in fact admitted to the kickback scheme. This Court is not permitted to re-weigh the evidence or discern the credibility of the witnesses.

Based upon the foregoing, Appellant Michael Craft's appeal is not well taken and is hereby dismissed. Costs are assessed to the Appellant. There being no just reason for delay, this is a final appeallable decision.
