The Jurors of the Grand Jury of the County of Stark and State of Ohio, duly impaneled, sworn and charged to inquire of and present all offenses whatever committed within the limits of said County, on their said oaths, in the name and by the authority of the State of Ohio, do find and present:

COUNT ONE

The grand jurors of Stark County, Ohio, by virtue of their aforesaid authority and oaths, do find and present that: **JAMAR FLEMING** on or about June 3, 2022 through May 21, 2025 in the County of Stark, Ohio aforesaid, did, with purpose to deprive the owner of property or services, knowingly obtain or exert control over either the property or services by deception; to wit: Jamar Fleming, CEO/Pastor of Agape Ministries, having solicited and accepted contributions of funds to Agape Ministries, a charitable organization holding such funds exclusively for charitable purposes, by deception, misused such funds for personal purposes and his own benefit, in violation of Section 2913.02(A)(3)(B)(2) of the Revised Code, a Felony of the Third Degree, against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

FURTHERMORE, the property or services stolen is valued at one hundred fifty thousand dollars or more and less than seven hundred fifty thousand dollars.

COUNT TWO

And the grand jurors of Stark County, Ohio, by virtue of their aforesaid authority and oaths, do find and present that: **JAMAR FLEMING** on or about June 3, 2022 through May 21, 2025 in the County of Stark, Ohio aforesaid, having devised a scheme to defraud, did knowingly disseminate, transmit, or cause to be disseminated or transmitted by means of a wire, radio, satellite, telecommunication, telecommunications device, telecommunication service, or voice over internet protocol service any writing, data, sign, signal, picture, sound, or image with purpose to execute or otherwise further the scheme to defraud; and the violation occurred as part of a course of conduct involving other violations of division (A) or (B) of Section 2913.05 or violations of, attempts to violate, conspiracies to violate, or complicity in violations of Section 2913.02, 2913.04, 2913.11, 2913.21, 2913.31, 2913.42, 2913.43, or 2921.13 of the Revised Code; to wit: Jamar Fleming, CEO/Pastor of Agape Ministries, having solicited and accepted contributions of funds to Agape Ministries, a charitable organization holding such funds exclusively for charitable purposes, by deception, misused such funds for personal purposes and his own benefit through a series of financial transactions and transfers completed via telecommunications networks, in violation of Section 2913.05(A)(E)(1) of the Revised Code, a Felony of the Second Degree, against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

FURTHERMORE, the value of the benefit obtained by Jamar Fleming or of the detriment to the victim of the fraud is one hundred fifty thousand dollars or more but less than one million dollars.

COUNT THREE

And the grand jurors of Stark County, Ohio, by virtue of their aforesaid authority and oaths, do find and present that: **JAMAR FLEMING** on or about April 15, 2026 in the County of Stark, Ohio aforesaid, did knowingly fail to file any return or report required to be filed under Chapter 5747 of the Revised Code; to wit: Jamar Fleming failed to file an annual income tax return for taxable year 2025 as required by Section 5747.08 of the Revised Code, in violation of Section 5747.19, 5747.99(A) of the Revised Code, a Felony of the Fifth Degree, against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

COUNT FOUR

And the grand jurors of Stark County, Ohio, by virtue of their aforesaid authority and oaths, do find and present that: **JAMAR FLEMING** on or about April 15, 2025 in the County of Stark, Ohio aforesaid, did knowingly fail to file any return or report required to be filed under Chapter 5747 of the Revised Code; to wit: Jamar Fleming failed to file an annual income tax return for taxable year 2024 as required by Section 5747.08 of the Revised Code, in violation of Section 5747.19, 5747.99(A) of the Revised Code, a Felony of the Fifth Degree, against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

COUNT FIVE

And the grand jurors of Stark County, Ohio, by virtue of their aforesaid authority and oaths, do find and present that: **JAMAR FLEMING** on or about April 15, 2024 in the County of Stark, Ohio aforesaid, did file or knowingly cause to be filed an incomplete, false, or fraudulent return, report, or statement; to wit: Jamar Fleming filed an annual individual income tax return for taxable year 2023 omitting income subject to Ohio income tax that he had received during that year, in violation of Section 5747.19, 5747.99(A) of the Revised Code, a Felony of the Fifth Degree, against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

COUNT SIX

And the grand jurors of Stark County, Ohio, by virtue of their aforesaid authority and oaths, do find and present that: **JAMAR FLEMING** on or about April 18, 2023 in the County of Stark, Ohio aforesaid, did knowingly fail to file any return or report required to be filed under Chapter 5747 of the Revised Code; to wit: Jamar Fleming failed to file an annual income tax return for taxable year 2022 as required by Section 5747.08 of the Revised Code, in violation of Section 5747.19, 5747.99(A) of the Revised Code, a Felony of the Fifth Degree, against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

COUNT SEVEN

And the grand jurors of Stark County, Ohio, by virtue of their aforesaid authority and oaths, do find and present that: **AGAPE MINISTRIES** on or about June 3, 2022 through May 21, 2025 in the County of Stark, Ohio aforesaid, did, with purpose to deprive the owner, of property or services, did knowingly obtain or exert control over either the property or services by deception; and acting with the kind of culpability otherwise required for the commission of the offense, its commission was authorized, requested, commanded, tolerated, or performed by the board of directors, trustees, partners, or by a high managerial officer, agent, or employee acting in behalf of the organization and within the scope of such a board's or person's office or employment; to wit: Jamar Fleming, CEO/Pastor of Agape Ministries, having solicited and accepted contributions of funds to Agape Ministries, a charitable organization holding such funds exclusively for charitable purposes, by deception, misused such funds for personal purposes and his own benefit through a series of financial transactions and transfers completed via telecommunications networks, in violation of Section 2913.02(A)(3)(B)(2) of the Revised Code, a Felony of the Third Degree, against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.



And the grand jurors of Stark County, Ohio, by virtue of their aforesaid authority and oaths, do find and present that: **AGAPE MINISTRIES** on or about June 3, 2022 through May 21, 2025 in the County of Stark, Ohio aforesaid, having devised a scheme to defraud, did knowingly disseminate, transmit, or cause to be disseminated or transmitted by means of a wire, radio, satellite, telecommunications, telecommunications device, telecommunications service, or voice over internet protocol service any writing, data, sign, signal, picture, sound, or image with purpose to execute or otherwise further the scheme to defraud; the violation occurred as part of a course of conduct involving other violations of division (A) or (B) of Section 2913.05 or violations of, attempts to violate, conspiracies to violate, or complicity in violations of Section 2913.02, 2913.04, 2913.11, 2913.21, 2913.31, 2913.42, 2913.43, or 2921.13 of the Revised Code; and acting with the kind of culpability otherwise required for the commission of the offense, its commission was authorized, requested, commanded, tolerated, or performed by the board of directors, trustees, partners, or by a high managerial officer, agent, or employee acting in behalf of the organization and within the scope of such a board's or person's office or employment, to wit: Jamar Fleming, CEO/Pastor of Agape Ministries, having solicited and accepted contributions of funds to Agape Ministries, a charitable organization holding such funds exclusively for charitable purposes, by deception, misused such funds for personal purposes and his own benefit through a series of financial transactions and transfers completed via telecommunications networks, in violation of Section 2913.05(A)(E)(1) of the Revised Code, a Felony of the Second Degree, against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

FURTHERMORE, the value of the benefit obtained by Jamar Fleming or of the detriment to the victim of the fraud is one hundred fifty thousand dollars or more but less than one million dollars.
