12/4/2012 EVIDENCE TRANSFER & SUBMISSION

Summary

On Tuesday, December 4, 2012, BCI Special Agent Daniel Winterich took custody of evidence from the East Cleveland Police Department and BCI Agents. These items were submitted to the BCI Laboratory or submitted into BCI Temporary Evidence.

Details

On Tuesday, December 4, 2012, at approximately 1000 hours, East Cleveland Detective Mike DeLisle arrived at the BCI offices in Richfield and turned over to Agent Winterich the evidence collected from the crime scene, the bullets collected at the autopsies, and a cartridge case recovered in front of the Justice Center by the Cleveland Police Department.

BCI Agent John Saraya turned over two gunshot residue (GSR) kits and a cell phone collected at autopsy by personnel from the Medical Examiner's Office. Also, Agent J.P. Rigaud turned over twelve Glock handguns and one Remington shotgun which had been turned over by CPD.

All of the items were submitted to the BCI Laboratory for technical examination except for the cell phone, a set of keys from the scene, and a vehicle part from the scene. See the evidence submission sheet for further details.
