01/03/2013 REQUEST FOR CLEVELAND POLICE RECORDS

Summary

On Wednesday, January 2, 2013, Special Agent Eric Lehnhart made a second request for records from James Chura, Commander of the Bureau of Special Investigations, City of Cleveland, Ohio Division of Police.

Details

On Wednesday, January 2, 2013, Special Agent Supervisor Dennis Sweet contacted Special Agent Eric Lehnhart via cellular telephone and requested that Special Agent Lehnhart contact Commander Chura to follow up on a previous records request that was initiated approximately one (1) week prior. The original request had not been received and due to the time limitations BCI Agents were approaching, SAS Sweet believed it would be beneficial to reach out to Commander Chura.

This e-mail contained Special Agent Eric Lehnhart's electronic signature at the bottom. At 2:56 PM Commander Chura forwarded the electronic mail to Lieutenant Cutlip and Sergeant Carney requesting that the documents be collected and forwarded to him for advancement to the BCI Investigative Team.

On Thursday, January 3, 2013 at 6:33 AM Commander Chura sent a portion of the requested information. The provided information was a Microsoft Spreadsheet containing the Names, Nature of Offense, and Disposition of Vehicle Pursuits that have happened in the previous three (3) years.

At 3:46 PM Commander Chura replied additionally by advising the following:

"SAS Sweet,

The below link has the personnel files that was supplied to the TV stations by the City of Cleveland, Department of Human Resources. The files provided to you on each of the officers were from our Personnel Unit. Access to the Integrity Control Section, Internal Affairs Unit, files are denied at this time. Please continue to contact me should you require any other assistance. Sincerely,"

A response was generated thanking Commander Chura for his effort and an explanation for the denial.

On Friday, January 4, 2013 at 9:30 AM, Cuyahoga County Prosecuting Attorney Timothy McGinty and Assistant Prosecutor Rick Bell met with Special Agent Supervisor Dennis Sweet and members of the BCI Investigative team at the BCI Richfield Northeast Regional Office. During the session, it was determined by the Prosecuting Attorney that the Investigative Team should have the same documentation that the news media had received. A subpoena will be issued by the Prosecutor's Office for the complete personnel files that were originally declined by Commander Chura.


