SEARCH WARRANT FOR RECORDS

Summary

In the course of the investigation of the officer involved shooting on November 29, 2012, it was learned that the occupants of the subject vehicle had been staying at shelters under the auspices of the Alcohol, Drug Addiction & Mental Health Services Board of Cuyahoga County (MHS). Investigators contacted MHS for assistance in this investigation. Brief information was given since MHS operates under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) guidelines. As such, information could not be released without judicial authority.

Details

SA Saraya met with Assistant Cuyahoga County Prosecutor Mary McGrath and worked on an affidavit and search warrant. Information learned during the investigation provided substantial information on Timothy Russell. This information was put forward in the affidavit.

On Tuesday, January 15, 2013, SA Saraya met with Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Judge Brian Corrigan who reviewed the affidavit and warrant. Judge Corrigan approved and signed the warrant.

SA Saraya traveled to the MHS offices on Payne Ave. and served the warrant on the Director of Quality Improvement, Karen Madzia. Madzia had photocopied the whole file that was maintained on Russell. The information contained referred to an incident in 2010, his recent admission to North Point Transitional Housing, and his autopsy report.

Madzia was given a copy of the warrant and a signed receipt for the documentation.

On Wednesday, January 16, 2013 SA Saraya made the return to Judge Corrigan and filed the paperwork in the Cuyahoga County Clerk's Office (see attachment).

BRIEF

Special Agent John Saraya of the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation, affiant in the above-described search warrant, has informed the Cuyahoga County Prosecutor's Office that he executed the above-described search warrant on January _______, 2013. The warrant for Timothy Russell's records maintained by Mental Health Services was requested in the course of an investigation into a police pursuit and officer-involved shooting on November 29, 2012, that ended in Russell's death. As a result of the information in the search warrant, affidavit, and return, and other information collected, BCI&I and other agencies are conducting an investigation into these events. The release of information regarding the activities of BCI&I relative to their investigation could compromise the investigation and would reveal Timothy Russell's personal information to the public. For these reasons, it is therefore necessary to seal the search warrant and affidavit.

In the interest of justice, to protect the integrity of the on-going investigation, and to protect the personal information of Timothy Russell, the undersigned, on behalf of the State of Ohio, respectfully requests this Honorable Court grant this Motion to Seal Search Warrant, Affidavit, and Return in the above-captioned matter until further order of the Court, i.e., until such time as the Court determines it may be unsealed.
