Summary Report

Incident: Cleveland Police Department (CPD) pursuit and officer involved shooting, November 29, 2012.

The following was conducted on January 17th, 2013, in conjunction with the captioned investigation. Detective James Mackey, Sergeant Clifford Pinkney, and Detective David Jacobs (author) drove the pursuit route to determine an exact amount of stop signs, traffic lights, and intersections. The following are the results:

Starting at the intersection of St. Clair Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio and West Third Street, Cleveland, Ohio and ending at Heritage Middle School, East Cleveland, Ohio it was determined that there are eight (8) stop signs, seventy-one (71) traffic lights, and one-hundred and eighty-nine (189) intersections. These observations were derived from the route of the captioned pursuit.
