EVIDENCE PICK-UP AND ESCORT

Summary

On Monday, December 03, 2012, SA Rigaud and SA Saraya traveled to the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office to retrieve evidence.

Details

Agents arrived and met with Curtis Jones of the Medical Examiner's Lab. The vehicle, a 1979 blue, Chevrolet Malibu, Ohio registration FSA 3495, involved in the officer-involved shooting was in a secured bay. Jones said that personnel had removed the two bodies from the vehicle and then emptied out the items from the back seat to see if a firearm or casing was evident. Nothing was located. The property was lying out on clean craft paper.





SA Saraya placed the property back in the rear seat area of the car.

Lying on the front seat, in the driver's position, was a flip-phone cell phone. It was noted and left. Jones advised that another phone had been found in the clothing of the passenger. Jones also said that the bodies had been processed and GSR collection kits used on them. As yet, the medical examiner's office had not processed them. The phone, GSR kits, and car were signed over to SA Saraya.

Agents followed the car as it was transported on a flatbed from the medical examiner's office to the BCI Richfield Investigation's garage and turned over to members of the Crime Scene Unit. The phone and GSR kits were secured in the BCI Investigations Temporary Evidence Room until they are to be submitted.
