12/09/2012 OSP AVL INFORMATION

Summary

On Wednesday, December 9, 2012 Special Agent Eric Lehnhart reviewed Automatic Vehicle Locator (AVL) information provided by the Ohio State Highway Patrol.

Details

Special Agent Eric Lehnhart received from Special Agent Mark Kollar a white paper compact disc holder. Kollar asked that the information contained on the disc be viewed and summarized.

Contained inside the white paper compact disc holder was one (1) silver Staples CD-R. This is a readable 52x 700 MB 80-minute disc. The file located on the disc was titled "OSHP Locations.pdf" and was created on December 6, 2012 at 1:00 PM. File size was 5.00 MB (5,253,583 bytes). There is only one file located on the silver disc.

The saved Portable Document Format (pdf) file contained 12 images. The images were maps depicting the road structure around the Cleveland Metropolitan area. There were red markings on the maps that indicated where the vehicle was at the listed times. All vehicle information provided was for November 29, 2012 between 10:00 PM to 11:59 PM.

The following AVL's Units were evaluated: Unit 0194, 0313, 0326, 0422, 0735, 0748, 0905, 1068, 1289, 1654, 1887, 1901. It appears that Unit 1068 was the only Unit that was near the pursuit route and near the Heritage Middle School at the time of the incident.

Additionally, while viewing the submitted RTA pole cameras, an OSP vehicle is clearly identified on camera entering the intersection of Superior and Euclid at 10:50:43 PM on November 29, 2012. The identified vehicle is operating its "all blue" overhead emergency lighting and is one vehicle in a group of several Cleveland Police vehicles who pass through the intersection. The video is not clear enough to identify a vehicle number.
