#### 12/18/2012 Review of Intersection Cameras from East Cleveland, Ohio

#### **Summary**

On December 18, 2012, Special Agent Perry Roeser was asked to review intersection cameras from the East Cleveland, Ohio area of the suspect vehicle and the pursuit vehicles from November 29, 2012. SA Roeser advised he would assist.

## **Details**

On December 18, 2012, SA Roeser was handed a compact disc that was marked: EC 04.05.11 11-29-12 2200-2300

The company that provided the compact disc to BCI is called ATS, American Traffic Solutions. ATS also forwarded images to Special Agent Mark Kollar's email which contained photographs of a red light violation of the suspect vehicle and all of the police cruisers during the pursuit.

The CD contains 3 three separate video files from different intersections in the East Cleveland area.

The first video viewed was EC04. All of the video cameras were affixed on Euclid Ave, East Cleveland, Ohio.

EC04 was at the corner of Euclid Ave and Eddy Rd. The camera was on a continuous feed, meaning no delays or interruptions. The camera view was westbound which viewed toward downtown Cleveland. It recorded the suspect vehicle (Chevrolet Malibu) and a total of 62 marked and unmarked police cruisers pass through the intersection in an active pursuit. Of the

cruisers viewed, most were dark in color and unreadable as far as which department they belonged to.

EC05 was affixed at the corner of Euclid Ave and Forrest Hills. This camera's view was eastbound on Euclid which faced away from Cleveland. The camera at this intersection was also on a continuous feed, meaning no delays. EC05 depicted the same images as EC04. EC05 and EC04 were only a couple of blocks apart.

As the suspect vehicle passed through both intersections (EC04-EC05) the occupants were not viewed. The angle of the camera did not allow the occupants to be viewed.

EC11 was at the corner of Euclid Ave and Lakeview Rd. This camera was also a continuous feed with no delays. The view from the camera was eastbound on Euclid Ave which faced away from Cleveland. Only a few cruisers with lights activated were viewed coming through the intersection. No suspect vehicle was captured coming into the intersection.

The still images that were emailed from ATS to SA Kollar were also viewed. They depicted a still photograph of the red light violation of the suspect vehicle at the corner of Euclid Ave and Lakeview Rd. The time on the photograph was 10:51:52 PM. There was also an image of the citation that was mailed to Mr. Timothy Russell in the amount of \$95.00 due on 12/28/2012.

The only posted time located on any of the viewed material was the citation time that was issued to Timothy Russell.
