Summary

On December 19, 2012 S/A Brenda McNeely received a Cleveland Division of Police Property Damage report number 12-309836 involving damage to a CPD unit "288" (CNS2443) that happened on September 12, 2012. The damage to the vehicle was to the left front quarter panel, the same location as new damage from the pursuit / officer involved shooting on November 29, 2012. This report is to document pre-existing damage to the CPD unit (Reference damage documented in CS-18-12-82-1488).

On September 12, 2012 CPD unit 288, which is assigned Ohio registration CNS2443 was driven by Detective William Salupo Jr. #1969 and involved in a pursuit related to the apprehension of a drug offender. During the pursuit, the striking vehicle was parallel to Salupo's driver's side of

the vehicle and accelerated, turning towards CPD unit 288 and striking the front left quarter panel in a forward movement. The suspect was driving a black 2012 Chevrolet Impala.

Cleveland Police Department Officers Williams #1111 and Moten #2306 investigated the damage to vehicle and documented the damage. It was overseen by supervisor Lieutenant William Mone #8455.

The investigation revealed new damage to the left front headlight assembly and the left front corner of the bumper. No other damage was documented in the report. Photographs were not provided. This is the same impact area that received new damage on November 29, 2012 during the pursuit / officer involved shooting that occurred at 14410 Terrace, East Cleveland, Ohio. The property damage / investigation report is to be included in the case file.

A report from East Cleveland PD Detective Gardner advising when they received the e-mailed information and the e-mailed Property Damage Report are attached to this report.

On this date and time, Detectives received via electronic mail an attachment that was sent from Commander James Chura, with the Cleveland Police Department.

A request had previously been sent to Commander Chura reference an accident report on Second District Vice Car 288, bearing Ohio registration number CNS2442. Detectives had learned that this vehicle had been in a previous accident in September of 2012. Detectives were attempting to see the report and photographs of the original accident to determine damage to the vehicle then and compare it to the damage that occurred on November 29, 2012.

The report received is the internal reports for the City of Cleveland reference the accident in September 2012. The report does not contain original photographs at this time.

A subsequent message was sent to Commander Chura requesting if there were photographs taken. Commander Chura responded stating that their Accident Investigation Unit did photograph the vehicle and that he would be forwarding those photographs at a later time.

Sir;

On Wednesday, September 12, 2012, I reported for duty and assumed my duties as 2S80, OIC of the 2nd District Vice Unit. At approximately 2100 hours members of the unit were in the area of W.45 and Lorain staging in c/w a drug investigation directed by Det. John Graves #2225. A controlled purchase of drugs was made from a black male operating a black Chevy Impala. Following the sale the suspect went north on W.45 and then west on Franklin. When the suspect vehicle stopped for the red light at W.65 take down units with emergency lights activated moved in on both sides with Det. William Salupo Jr #1969 operating 288 on the right and Det. Kevin Fairchild #2138 operating 289 to the left. Det. Larry Smith #882, operating an undercover vehicle, was stopped immediately behind the suspect vehicle. When the suspect observed the take down units and detectives ordering him to raise his hands he first reacted by placing the vehicle in reverse and making contact with the undercover vehicle behind him. He then put the vehicle into drive, cut the wheel to the right and rammed the unmarked unit occupied by Det. Salupo. He then accelerated pushing Det. Salupo's vehicle sufficiently out of the way to proceed. He then fled north on W.65 then east on West Clinton. He then proceeded southbound on W.58 accelerating at a high rate of speed. After crossing Bridge Avenue the suspect was not able to negotiate the roadway which curved to the left and he crashed into a tree on the west side of W.58 just south of Lillian Ct. The suspect exited his vehicle and fled eastbound through a residential area. He was quickly apprehended by officers assigned to 2G37, P.O. Brian Charney #1700 and P.O. Don Horvat #2491. The suspect, now identified as Deondre Vaughn, complained of a foot injury. EMS was requested and responded, taking Vaughn to Metro Hospital where he was treated and released. Neither Det. Salupo nor Det. Smith was injured. There was no observable damage to the undercover vehicle driven by Det. Smith. The vehicle driven by Det. Salupo had extensive damage to the left front. SIU was requested in c/w the pursuit and AIU 7441 P.O. Williams #1111 and P.O. Moten #2306 responded for reports and photographs. None of the detective units involved in the pursuit are equipped with AVL.

This investigation concludes that Det. Salupo was engaged in the proper performance of his duties and was in compliance with all relevant GPO's and not in violation of the Rules and Regulations of the Department, the Ordinances of the City of Cleveland nor the Laws of the State of Ohio and I recommend that no further action be taken in regard to this incident.

ASSIGNMENT: On Wednesday, September 12th, 2012, while assigned to the Accident Investigation Unit (7441) company with P.O. Charles Moten #2306, upon reporting for duty at 2230hrs, we received an assignment to respon to W. 58th Street near Madison Avenue c/w two Cleveland Police cars struck during a pursuit. Lt. Mone #8455 w requesting AIU. One male was reportedly arrested. RMS #2012-00296380.

SCENE: Upon arrival near the southwest corner of W. 58th Street at Lillian Court, it was observed that a 20] Chevrolet Impala was off the right side of the road with the right front of the vehicle in contact with a large tree. this area, W. 58th is a residential Street which sustains traffic in North/South directions. W. 58th Street curves slight to a southeast heading travelling South from Lillian Court. The road surface is of asphalt construction. There are r pavement markings. The area is well lit. The road surface was dry. We received information from Lt. Mone, De Lawrence Smith #882 and Det. William Salupo Jr. #1969. Lt. Mone reported that his subordinates were operating unmarked Police vehicles while conducting drug enforcement activities. Det. Smith #882 was operating a 2004 Jee Liberty. Det. Salupo #1969 was operating a 2010 Ford Crown Victoria. The 2012 Chevrolet was the suspect vehicle operated by Deondre E. Vaughn, B/M/29. During their investigation, the suspect was stopped in the 2012 Chevrole on W. 65th Street and Franklin Avenue. Det. Smith was in the 2004 Jeep stopped behind the suspect. Det. Salup approached operating the 2010 Ford along with additional units to assist in the arrest of Mr. Vaughn. Mr. Vaugh backed the 2012 Chevrolet, purposefully colliding with the front of the 2004 Jeep. Mr. Vaughn then drove forward striking the left front of the 2010 Ford and attempting to flee from the Detectives. Det. Salupo pursued the suspec with the emergency lights and siren in use. A brief chase led to W. 58th Street, southbound. Mr. Vaughn wa operating at an excessive speed, failed to control the 2012 Chevrolet and travelled off the right side of the road sout of Lillian Court and struck a large tree. Mr. Vaughn exited the disabled vehicle, attempted to flee on foot, but wa apprehended by Detectives after a brief foot pursuit. Mr. Vaughn was conveyed from the scene to MetroHealtl Medical center by EMS 16 c/w a possible right leg injury as a result of the crash.

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<u>PHOTOGRAPHS:</u> Taken at the scene by P.O. Williams #1111; a total of fifty-two (52) digital photographs using the Nikon D90 EOS camera. The Photographs were assigned Log Number 12D-283.

<u>HOSPITAL</u>: At Metrohealth Medical Center we contacted the arrested male, Deondre Vaughn who was being treated c/w fractured bones to the right foot per Dr. Tshiner. Mr. Vaughn appeared to be free of the effects of alcoho or drugs of abuse at the time of interview. Mr. Vaughn refused to make further statements at that time.

NOTIFICATIONS: On scene Supervisor, Lt. Mone #8455. Accident Investigation Unit OIC, Sgt. Tyhulski #9543.

<u>SYNOSIS</u>: Deondre E. Vaughn, B/M/29, operated a 2012 Chevrolet Impala on W. 65th Street at Franklin Avenue, purposefully backed the vehicle striking a 2004 Jeep Liberty, an unmarked Police vehicle operated by Det. Smith #882. Mr. Vaughn then operated forward purposefully striking a 2010 Ford Crown Victoria, an unmarked Police vehicle operated by Det. Salupo #1969. Mr. Vaughn fled in the vehicle. The Detectives pursued with emergency lights and sirens in use. A brief vehicle pursuit proceeded South on W. 58th Street. As Mr. Vaughn operated at a recklessly excessive speed, he failed to control the vehicle which rotated clockwise, travelled off the right side of the road south of Lillian Court, where the right front of the vehicle struck a large tree. The Chevrolet was disabled and Mr. Vaughn was arrested after a brief foot chase.

Sir,

On September 12, 2012, while assigned to the Second District Vice Unit with Detectives Smith #882, Rinkus #2182, Mitchell #1191, Fairchild #2138, Graves #2225, Sgt. Coleman #9987, and Lt. Mone #8455, I had the occasion to arrest DEONDRE VAUGHN after a police pursuit for VSDL and FELONIOUS ASSAULT ON A POLICE OFFICER. Below are the facts of this incident.

Det. Graves had just completed a control buy from a black male (later learned to be DEONDRE VAUGHN) in the area of W 45 St and Franklin Ave. Det. Graves informed the unit that a good buy did indeed take place from VAUGHN and that VAUGHN was now driving west on Franklin Ave. Detectives then began to follow VAUGHN who was operating a 2012 Chevy Impala with Ohio License Plate P642371. I was assigned to a one man Detective Vehicle 288, a 2010 Ford Crown Victoria with Ohio License Plate CNS2443. We were stopped at the red light at West 58 and upon it turning green, VAUGHN, the other Detectives and myself proceeded west on Franklin Ave. We approached W 65th Street and Detective Graves decided that since we were pulling up to a red light this would be the perfect time to take down VAUGHN. Detective Smith stopped directly behind VAUGHN in an undercover vehicle. It was then that Detectives pulled up on the left side of VAUGHN at the same time I pulled up on the right side and we immediately activated our lights and sirens.

VAUGHN noticed this and looked to his right directly at me. I immediately yelled "Police, Put the car in park". It was at this time VAUGHN put his vehicle in reverse and struck Detective Smiths vehicle. VAUGHN then put his car in drive, pushed the gas to the floor, turned his wheel to the right and attempted to pull away from us. As VAUGHN did this he struck the front left side of my vehicle and pushed it to the curb. VAUGHN drove through my vehicle causing damage to the front left corner panel and front bumper. VAUGHN then drove up over the curb and onto the sidewalk and then west toward West 65th St. A police pursuit was then initiated as VAUGHN operated his vehicle north on W 65 on the sidewalk towards Clinton Ave. As VAUGHN reached Clinton Ave he drove through a parking lot and onto the street and then operated east on Clinton at a high rate of speed.

As VAUGHN reached W 58 he proceeded south on W 58 at a high rate of speed as well. VAUGHN ran the red light at Bridge Ave and proceeded toward Madison. As VAUGHN approached the curve prior to Madison he lost control of his vehicle and struck a tree at W 58 and Lillian Ct. VAUGHN then bailed and led Detectives and assisting Officers on a foot chase. VAUGHN was then apprehended at 1977 W 58 by Officers Charney and Horvat.

Sir:

On September 12, 2012 while assigned to the Second District Vice Unit in company with Detectives Graves #2225, Salupo #1969, Smith #882, Mitchell #1191, Sgt. Coleman #9987 and supervised by Lt Mone #8455 we arrested Deondre Vaughn for VSDL and Felonious Assault on PO. Below are the facts of that incident.

I was utilizing a Detective Vehicle this day. During my tour I learned that Det. Graves had a control buy set up for that area of W45 and Franklin. The buy was completed and we were informed by Det. Graves that the seller who was later ID as Deondre Vaughn was operating a Chevy Impala with a license plate of P642371. We followed Mr. Vaughn for a short time and we decided to make the stop at W65 and Franklin because the traffic signal was red. Det. Smith who was operating an undercover vehicle stopped directly behind Mr. Vaughn. At this time Det. Salupo and I who were operating detective vehicles pulled up on both sides of Mr. Vaughn vehicle. Det. Salupo stopped on the passenger side and I stopped on the driver's side. As I stopped I activated my lights and exited me vehicle. As I was exiting my vehicle Mr. Vaughn put his vehicle in reverse and struck the undercover vehicle operated by Det. Smith. I went around to the front of my detective vehicle and pulled out my city issued firearm pointing it at Mr. Vaughn yelling at him repeatedly to stop his vehicle and to put it into park. Mr. Vaughn then put the vehicle in drive and accelerated and turned his wheel to the right striking Det. Salupo in his vehicle knocking his vehicle out of the way.

Mr. Vaughn then drove up on the sidewalk west and then north on W65th. I then re-entered into my detective vehicle and assisted in the chase as the secondary vehicle. Mr. Vaughn drove eastbound on W. Clinton and then southbound on W58th. Mr. Vaughn refused to obey any of our orders to stop along with any of the traffic control devices. As Mr. Vaughn approached Madison Av Mr. Vaughn lost control of his vehicle and slammed into a tree. Mr. Vaughn jumped out of the vehicle and ran a short distance. Mr. Vaughn was caught in the rear of 1977 W58th by Officers Charney and Horvath. Mr. Vaughn complained of pain in his foot and was transported to Metro ER by EMS where he was treated and released.

On September 12, 2012 while I was assigned to the 2nd District Vice Unit along with Detective's Salupo #1969, Rinkus #2182, Graves #2225, Fairchild #2138, MItchell #1191, Sgt. Coleman #9987 and Lt. Mone #8455 we had the occasion to arrest Deondre Vaughn in connection with VSDL (Trafficking) and Felonious Assault on a Police Officer. Below are the facts of this incident.

On September 12,2012 Detective Graves just completed a buy from a black male (later identified as Deondre Vaughn) in the area of W.45 St and Bridge Ave. After the buy was completed and Detective Graves verified the buy was good. Detective Graves advised assisting units that Deondre Vaughn was traveling north bound on W.45th towards Franklin Ave. in a dark Chevy Impala with a license plate of P642371.

I then continued north bound on W.47th towards Franklin Ave. once at Franklin I observed the dark Chevy Impala make a west bound turn onto Franklin Ave. At this time I got behind the Impala that was operated by Deondre Vaughn and followed him west bound on Franklin Ave. towards W.65th. As we approached W.65th and Franklin and we had a red light facing us it was decided we would stop the vehicle at this time. With me directly behind the Impala. The take down units activated there over head lights and sirens to complete a felony stop on the Chevy Impala operated by Deondre Vaughn. Once Deondre Vaughn comprehended he was being stopped Deondre Vaughn immediately placed his car in reverse and slammed into the Jeep Liberty I was operating. When Deondre Vaughn noticed he wasn't getting no place in that direction he then placed the car in drive and cut his wheels to the right and slammed into Detective Salupo causing damage to Detective Salupo's unit.

At this time Deondre Vaughn went over the sidewalk at west 65th and Franklin and then turned northbound on West 65th. Deondre Vaughn then turned eastbound onto West Clinton. Deondre Vaughn operated the Chevy Impala at a high rate of speed and in a reckless manner as he continued east bound on West Clinton. Deondre Vaughn then turned south bound onto W.58 as he continued to operate his unit in a reckless manner and without due car citizens. Deondre Vaughn crossed over Franklin and Bridge Ave as he proceeded south bound on West 58th without even slowing down for on coming traffic or even the possibility of pedestraines. Deondre Vaughn continued southbound at a high rate of speed on West 58th until losing control at West 58th and Madison.

At which time Deondre Vaughn crashed into a tree on the curd rather then making the turn. Deondre Vaughn attempted to flee on foot but was apprehended by P.O. Charney and Horvath on west 58th place (the alley directly east of W.58th). Sgt. Coleman and Lt. Mone on scene as well as P.O. Moton and P.O. Williams of AIU.

SUBJECT Investigation of Deondre Vaughn and Amanda Bykowski

Sir:

On September 12, 2012, while assigned to the Second District Vice Unit with Detectives Fairchild #2138, Mitchell #1191, Smith #882, Salupo #1969, Rinkus #2182, Sgt. Coleman #9987, Lt. Mone #8355 and being assisted by Officers Charney #1700 and Horvat #2491, we had the occasion to arrest Deondre Vaughn and made a name suspect of Amanda Bykowski. Below are the facts of this investigation.

On the above date I received information from a CRI that a female named Amanda, later identified as Amanda Bykowski, was allowing drug dealers to sell drugs and Amanda was also middling drug deals from her residence at 1922 West 45th. The CRI advised me also that Brandy, daughter of Amanda lives in the residence and is a drug user. Utilizing this CRI an investigation was initiated and we attempted to make a controlled purchase of heroin from Amanda Bykowski.

We made a controlled call to the cellular telephone number 440-265-4898 and the phone was answered by Amanda. An amount of heroin was requested and Amanda stated to come over that the dealer was on his way. The CRI was searched and then issued an amount of CPD buy money which the serial numbers had been prerecorded. I then drove the CRI to the area of 1922 West 45 and let the CRI out of my vehicle. Detective Mitchell had set up a stationary surveillance position on 1922 West45th.

The CRI entered 1922 West 45th and met with Amanda and gave Amanda the CPD buy money. After a short period of time a 2012 Chevy Impala pulled in front of the residence and parked directly behind Det. Mitchell. Amanda and the CRI exited the residence and the CRI waited on the porch while Amanda met with the driver of the Impala, later identified as Deondre Vaughn. Amanda entered the vehicle and made a hand to hand transaction with Vaughn. Amanda exited the vehicle and met with the CRI and hand the CRI an amount of heroin. The vehicle then drove off with Detectives following. The CRI returned to this Detective and turned over the purchased heroin. Amanda then entered the residence. Det. Mitchell witnessed the drug sale.

The vehicle was followed to Franklin and West 58 where it was stopped behind a vehicle in traffic at the red light. Det. Smith was behind the vehicle and Det. Salupo had pulled up in the right lane. Take down Officers pulled up to the left side of the vehicle and activated there lights and sirens. Vaughn observed Officers and put his vehicle in reverse intentionally striking Det. Smith. Vaughn then turned to the right intentionally ramming Det. Salupo pushing his vehicle up over the curb. Vaughn then fled driving up over the sidewalk then north on West 65 down the sidewalk to Clinton Ave. where he went through a parking lot then eastbound in the street. I immediately notified police radio.

SUBJECT Investigation of Deondre Vaughn and Amanda Bykowski

A pursuit was initiated. The vehicle continued east on Clinton then south on West 58 at a high rate of speed. The vehicle operated through a top red light then lost control striking a tree at West 58 and Lillian Ct. The driver, Vaughn, bailed out of the vehicle and fled on foot. Vaughn was pursued on foot and apprehended in the rear yard of 1977 West 58th by Officers Charney and Horvat. Vaughn was placed under arrest without incident and advised of his rights. Vaughn was in possession of the CPD buy money along with an additional \$89.00 cash and a cell phone.

Det. Fairchild checked the vehicle and found baggies of crack cocaine and heroin packaged and ready for sale on the drivers door and floorboard. There was also another cell phone in the vehicle. While on scene Vaughn's cell phone rang and the name on the phone was Amanda/Brandy 440-265-4898. I asked Vaughn what he was thinking and he stated "I didn't want to go to jail." Vaughn then complained of foot and leg pain from the accident. EMS was requested and responded to the scene. Vaughn was conveyed to Metro Hospital where he was treated for a foot injury.

AIU was requested to the scene c/w the damaged vehicles. Car 7441 responded and took photographs and measurements. Auto process towed to CPD lot#2 c/w criminal tool.

I then requested Officers Charney and Horvat respond to 1922 West 45th to identify Amanda. Officers obtained the name and information of Amanda Bykowski. Det. Mitchell positively identified the OHLEG photo of Bykowski as the person who made the drug transaction with the CRI and Vaughn. All evidence was MTE at the Second District. Cleveland Division of Police pursuit form completed by Lt. Mone.

On September 14, 2012 I consulted the City Prosecutor and had a Drug Trafficking warrant issued for Amanda Bykowski. On September 14, 2012 I responded to 1922 West 45th with Officers Judd #30 and McGuth #536 to affect the arrest of Bykowski. Upon arriving Bykowski answered the door and I advised her of the complaints for her residence. Bykowski was advised of her rights and admitted that she has a bad drug problem. Bykowski stated she had some drug paraphernalia in her residence and that her daughter was also inside. I requested a consent to search and then entered the residence with Bykowski. We found Brandy Toth, daughter of Bykowski inside. Toth was advised of her rights. Bykowski and Toth both agreed to and signed a consent to search form. Bykowski had the cell phone with the number 440-265-4898. Bykowski stated that she has a bad drug problem. Toth also stated she has a drug problem. Bykowski and Toth both gave up spoons and paraphernalia with suspected heroin on them. A baggie with cocaine residue was also confiscated.
