*The Jurors of the Grand Jury of the State of Ohio, within and for the body of Summit County, on their oaths, in the name and by the authority of the State of Ohio, do find and present:*

DeShawn D. Dixon, on or about the 26th day of March, 2025 through the 25th day of November, 2025, in the county of Summit aforesaid, did recklessly dispose of solid waste by open burning or open dumping in violation of Ohio Revised Code §3734.03, 3734.99(A), **Solid Waste**, an unclassified felony.

*The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.*

**Count Two**

*The Grand Jurors do further find and present:*

DeShawn D. Dixon, on or about the 26th day of March, 2025 through the 11th day of February, 2026, in the county of Summit aforesaid, did recklessly dispose of solid waste by open burning or open dumping in violation of Ohio Revised Code §3734.03, 3734.99(A), **Solid Waste**, an unclassified felony.

*The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.*

**Count Three**

*The Grand Jurors do further find and present:*

DeShawn D. Dixon, on or about the 26th day of March, 2025 through the 11th day of February, 2026, in the county of Summit aforesaid, did recklessly operate or maintain a solid waste facility without a license issued under section 3734.05(A) by the board of health of the health district in which the facility was located or by the director of environmental protection when the health district in which the facility was located was not on the approved list under section

3734.08 of the Revised Code in violation of Ohio Revised Code §3734.05(A)(1), 3734.99(A), **Operate Solid Waste Facility Without a License**, an unclassified felony.

The said DeShawn D. Dixon did violate Ohio Administrative Rule 3745-400: disposal of construction & demolition debris by a prohibited method, namely disposal at an unlicensed disposal site.

The said DeShawn D. Dixon did remove multiple surveillance cameras Copley Township mounted near road access to Dixon's property


