## COUNT ONE:

JURORS OF THE GRAND JURY of the State of Ohio, within and for the body of the County aforesaid, on their oaths, in the name and by the authority of the State of Ohio, do find and present that on or about the 13th day of November, 2023, at 15 Jodie Lane, Apt. D, City of Wilmington in Clinton County, Ohio, KRISTINA M. ALEXANDER, did knowing make a false statement, or knowingly swear or affirm the truth of a false statement previously made, when the statement was made with purpose to mislead a public official in performing the public official's official function, namely, falsified the date when she actually provided written permission to Christopher J. Alexander to hunt white-tailed deer on private property at 1543 Shawnee Trace Road on a permission slip as October 1, 2023 instead of the actual date of November 13, 2023 to mislead a wildlife officer in the investigation of when written permission was actually given to hunt deer on her private property, in violation of Title 29, Section 2921.13(A)(3), 2921.13(F)(1)(Falsification, a misdemeanor

of the first degree) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

## COUNT TWO:

THE JURORS OF THE GRAND JURY of the State of Ohio, within and for the body of the County aforesaid, on their oaths, in the name and by the authority of the State of Ohio, do find and present that as a continuous course of conduct beginning on or about the 13th day of November, 2023, at 15 Jodie Lane, Apt. D, City of Wilmington and 1543 Shawnee Trace Road, Blanchester, Marion Township, in Clinton County, Ohio, KRISTINA M. ALEXANDER, did counsel, aid, shield or harbor an offender under Chapter 1531 or Chapter 1533 of the Revised Code or any division rule, namely, did aid or shield Christopher J. Alexander, a wildlife offender, who used her signed permission to hunt document as claimed proof of prior permission to hunt whitetailed deer on her private property purportedly beginning on October 1, 2023 when said written permission to hunt deer was not actually given until November 13, 2023 after the said Christopher J. Alexander's unlawful taking possession of an antlered deer, gamechecked as a 17-point antlered deer which later measured to be an 18-point antlered deer, and continued to shield him by affirming said false statement to wildlife officers that said written permission to hunt deer on her property was given purportedly on October 1, 2023, the violation concerned the taking or possession

of deer, in violation of Title 15, Section 1531.02, 1531.99(B), 1533.68(A) (Aiding a Wildlife Offender involving Taking or Possession of Deer in Violation of the Revised Code or Division Rule, a misdemeanor of the third degree) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.
