The Ohio Attorney General's Bureau of Criminal Investigation is seeking assistance to help locate missing person Michael Hodge. On March 6, 2004, witnesses reported Michael left on a 10-speed bicycle near the 4000 block of West 172nd Street near Puritas Avenue in Cleveland, Ohio. Michael has a scar on his left wrist, is missing his front four teeth, and has tattoos on his forearms.
