- Classroom instruction: Hundreds of courses are available at a main campus and tactical training center in London and a satellite campus in Richfield. The London campus offers overnight accommodations, a fitness center and a cafeteria.
- Law Enforcement Conference: Dozens of workshops and networking opportunities are available to Ohio's law enforcement professionals at this annual conference, typically held in the fall.
