Narrative:

On April 2, 2025, at approximately 1100 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation Special Agent Steven Seitzman received video footage from Evendale Assistant Chief of Police Sean McKinney. The video footage was from GE surveillance cameras, which captured a portion of the incident.

SA Seitzman reviewed the footage and noted the following:

Video file: EVEN WC-001, CAM 144-145 Parking Lot West(2)-2025-03-20 07.11.54.733 AM

This footage showed a subject walking on the shoulder of northbound I-75 at approximately 0254 hours, according to the timestamp in the video. The subject continued to walk north on I-75 past the GE Family Wellness Center and toward Glendale Milford Road. The subject walked out of the camera frame at approximately 0258 hours, according to the timestamp.

Video file: EVEN 152, BLDG 100 North (3)-2025-03-19 12.02.20.866 PM

This footage showed I-75 North near Glendale Milford Road. The relevant portion of the footage was difficult to decipher due to the distance between the camera and the involved subjects. At approximately 0309 hours, according to the timestamp, the emergency lights of a police cruiser were activated. At approximately 0310 hours, according to the timestamp, a subject walks north on I-75 behind the police cruiser. Two subjects can then be seen in front of the police cruiser near the shoulder of I-75, presumably [REDACTED] and Samuel Munyarutete. It appeared that [REDACTED] was in front of the subject and continued to back away from him. At approximately 0311 hours, a light can be seen coming from who is believed to be [REDACTED]. The figure believed to be [REDACTED] then moved around the subject and closer to the right lane of travel. The footage did not appear to contain any additional information.

This footage appeared to contain the subject later identified as Charles Jackson walking on GE property at approximately 0240 hours, according to the timestamp. The footage did not appear to contain any other relevant information.

The footage was provided to SA Seitzman on a thumb drive. SA Seitzman was only able to review the files using a proprietary player provided by GE. Consequently, the footage was placed in an envelope and added to the permanent case file.
