On Tuesday, January 31, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Shawn Rowley, along with SA Mathew Austin and SA Cassandra Tackett, were assigned to assist the Jackson County Sheriff's Office (JCSO) with an officer involved shooting incident. SA Rowley was requested by SA Tackett (BCI CSU lead agent) to respond to the JCSO headquarters to document the involved deputies. The primary scene was located at 1818 Jisco West Road in Jackson.

At approximately 1730 hours, SA Rowley photographed a total of five JCSO personnel. Four were present in the scene and reportedly did not fire their weapons. Those included Sheriff Ted Frazier, Sergeant Jason Wilson, Deputy Nick Spangler and Deputy Leif Smith. The fifth deputy was Lieutenant (Lt. , who had discharged his firearm and SA Rowley learned that his firearm had been left at the primary scene. Lt. reported his Taser was also discharged and SA Rowley collected this as item #1 (Taser X26, S/N).

All of the deputies were wearing their agency issued external vests that had Sheriff badges on the front with name tags and 'Sheriff' markings on the back, along with duty gear. Many of the deputies were wearing helmets and Lt. stated he was as well, but did not have it for the photo. SA Rowley photographed and documented the duty pistols as listed below:

The two extra magazines each deputy carried on their vest were photographed for documentation only. SA Rowley concluded his documentation of the JCSO Deputies at approximately 1830 hours. SA Rowley packaged and turned over the Taser to SA Tackett on January 31, 2023.
