- Victim's Rights aka Marsy's Law (name, address, phone number, and family member names), and 149.43(A)(1)(ii)(i) Due to their highly sensitive nature, photos of the victim at the scene of the death have been withheld.
- DV, Sex Offense, Stalking Victim-Marsy's Law, Ohio R.C. 149.43 (A)(17)(j) Information that could identify the alleged victim of a sex offense, menacing by stalking, or domestic violence.
