Narrative:

On Thursday, November 21, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber) compiled background information on James J. Vanest (Vanest), a subject involved in the incident on November 18, 2024 The information included researching past police reports involving the subject, searching criminal history records, court records (if applicable), open/closed-source database inquiries, and social media posts. The information gathered was obtained from BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit, Jackson County West Virginia Sheriff's Office, Perry Township Police Department, Ohio State Highway Patrol and the Mansfield Police Department (MPD).

SA Lieber reviewed the information and noted the following:

Prior Police Encounters:

SA Lieber contacted the Jackson County West Virginia Sheriff's Office and obtained a copy of report 24-0000459. The report related to a July 12, 2024, traffic stop and subsequent arrest of Vanest for two (2) counts of prohibited person in possession of a firearm.

The Perry Township Police Department provided a traffic crash report (2009-20992) that involved a vehicle accident where Vanest lost control of his vehicle.

The Ohio State Highway Patrol provided a report (16 442061 0201). This report detailed an allegation against Vanest while he was an inmate in the Mansfield Correctional Institution. The allegation was that Vanest put feces in the coffee of another inmate. Ultimately, the case was closed due to insufficient evidence.

A news article released on December 31, 2024, indicated that Vanest was linked to the April 29, 1981, murder of Debra Miller in Mansfield, Ohio. SA Lieber contacted MPD and obtained a summary of the investigation as well as DNA reports related to the case. Those documents have been attached to this report.





On or about July 12, 2024 at approximately 1232 hours, Jackson County 911 received a call pertaining to a reckless driver near the area of the 153 mile marker of Interstate 77 South. The caller advised dispatch that the vehicle in question was a gray Dodge four wheel drive pick up. The caller stated that the vehicle was driving erratically and speeding. The caller also advised that the vehicle vehicle was bearing OH registration HYK6895. Deputy Roush responded to the call for service.

Roush went to the 138 mile marker cross over and observed a vehicle matching the previous description, traveling south on I-77. The vehicle was in the left lane of travel, approaching road construction. Roush pulled out and observed the vehicle following too closely to the vehicle in front of it through the entirety of the construction zone. Roush approximates the distance between the pick up and the vehicle it was following to be roughly 6 to 10 feet. Once out of the construction zone, Roush observed the Dodge pick up bearing OH registration HYK6895, passing a vehicle. Roush got behind the pick up and paced the vehicle for approximately 10 seconds. The vehicle was traveling approximately 85 MPH in a posted 70 MPH zone. The driver then hit his brakes hard and pulled into the right lane, directly behind another vehicle. The pick up was again following too closely to the vehicle in front of it, leaving approximately 6 to 10 feet between him and the vehicle in front. Roush also observed the passenger side tail light hanging by only the wires.

Roush initiated a traffic stop near the 132 mile marker south. As the vehicle was pulling onto the side of the road, The vehicle nearly spun out of control while coming to a stop. Roush contacted the driver from the passenger side of the vehicle. The driver was identified though his Ohio operators as James Vanest. Though out the conversation, James appeared to be nervous and asked for a break. While speaking with him, Roush detected the odor of raw marijuana emitting from the vehicle. James also stated that he just purchased the vehicle and it did not have insurance. Roush checked the status of his operator's through dispatch. Roush then went back to the passenger side of the vehicle and asked James to exit the vehicle. He obliged and exited the vehicle. Once at the back of the vehicle, Roush patted James for weapons. Roush removed a knife clipped to the side of James' pocket and felt what Roush knew to be a fire arm in the rear waistband of his shorts. After removing the fire arm, four magazines, and knife from James' person, Roush asked him if there was anything illegal in the vehicle. James stated he smokes marijuana and there was some marijuana in the vehicle inside a box.

Inside the vehicle, Roush located a bag of a green leafy substance believed to be marijuana in a box in the back seat. The marijuana was later weighed and weighed approximately 55.56 grams. Roush also located another firearm inside a black duffel bag in the back seat. Inside the duffel bag was \$30,000 in US Currency and a cashiers check for \$25,000. The currency was all \$100 bills and in bank bands. Two bands of \$10,000 and 5 bands of \$2,000. James was also traveling with two 5 gallon canister's of gasoline in the cab behind the front seats. While on the roadside, Roush asked dispatch to check his criminal history and it showed he was a convicted felon.

James was placed under arrest and Roush transported him to the Jackson County Sheriff's office. Roush also transported the duffel bag containing the cash, the cashier's check, firearms, and other personal items to the Sheriff's office. James Vanest's truck was towed to the Jackson County Sheriff's Office.

Deputy Casto interviewed James once at the Jackson County Sheriff's Office. Casto read James his Miranda Rights and James agreed to talk with Casto. James stated that he had recently sold his house and went through several thousand dollars within a few days. James stated that he paid cash for the truck he was operating. James stated that he was going to Beckley, WV to buy a house and that is what the cashier's check and cash was for. After looking at the address that James stated he traveling to buy, it appeared there was no house at the address.

James admitted to his driving violations while under Miranda.

Under Miranda, James admitted that he knows he is a felon and is not allowed to possess firearms. James admitted to "carrying" (firearms) every day. He stated he is worried about the end of the world type times. James admitted to buying a whole lot of ammunition online and he admitted that he knew he wasn't allowed to own ammunition

The firearm that was located in James' waistband was black, EAA corp 10mm pistol. The firearm that was located in the duffel bag was a black BRG USA 9mm pistol.

After further investigation, The \$30,000 cash, along with the James' wallet, went to South Central Regional Jail with him. The rest of James' property, including the \$25,000 cashier's check was placed back in James' vehicle and locked. All pertinent evidence to this case was logged and placed in the Jackson County Sheriff's department's evidence room.

Roush asked dispatch to check James' criminal history.

Roush arrested James J. Vanest for two (2) counts of Prohibited person in possession of a firearm, WV State Code 61-7-7(1).

Casto obtained a search warrant for each of James' cell phones. The information from each cell phone was forensically extracted by Sergeant Williams on or about July 12 2024. The extracted information is attached to the case file.



Present during the interview with Inmate Myron Lemaster were Inmate Lemaster and Trooper Butler. Inmate Lemaster explained that he went up to get cup of coffee granules to make instant coffee from his room, and return downstairs where he could get a shot of hot water. He said that he noticed something floating in the coffee, and stated there is something wrong with this coffee. Inmate Lemaster said he poured out the coffee into the water fountain.

Inmate Lemaster said that he found some feces in the bottom of the cup. He explained that he was removed from his cell to another cell. Inmate Lemaster told me that he went to the infirmary, and the nurse said it was feces. He told me that they may had a couple words a couple of months ago, but nothing recently.

My interview with Inmate Lemaster concluded at around 1348 hours, and he returned to his cell.

At around 1428 hours, I brought Inmate James Vanest, A652-565 to Osp Investigator office of Segregation for a digitally recorded voluntary statement about the incident. Inmate Vanest was advised of his Constitutional Rights, and he acknowledged his rights by signing the Constitutional Waiver. He was asked to provide a voluntary statement and is summarized as follows:

Present during the interview with Inmate James Vanest were Inmate Vanest and Trooper Butler. Inmate Vanest explained that he didn't know anything about the allegation that has been brought against by Inmate Lemaster. He told me that he did not put anything in the mans coffee and/or doesn't know anyone else who would have done so.

Man shot to death at Stark County motel linked to 1981 homicide in Mansfield

MANSFIELD - Police have solved a 43year-old cold case homicide, with the break coming after the killer was shot to death in a Stark County motel last month.

Debra Lee Miller, 18, a waitress at the former Mr. T's Coffee Shop, was found brutally murdered in her apartment on April 29, 1981.

Mansfield Police Chief Jason Bammann on Monday said she was killed by the late James Vanest, who lived above Miller during the night of the homicide. Vanest had been questioned during the initial investigation but was never identified as

"The DNA evidence collected from multiple items, when analyzed alongside the findings in Mansfield police detective

Terry Butler's investigation, establishes proof beyond a reasonable doubt that Vanest committed the murder of Debra Miller on April 29, 1981," Bammann said. "Because of this, we now consider the case closed.

** BRENDA PORTER **

Brenda Porter stated she worked with Debbie Miller on the night of April 28, 1981. She stated that nothing unusual happened that particular night.

She stated that Debbie Miller drank alot and had one boyfriend that frequented Mr. T's Restaurant; that being Harry Davis. The other males that came into the coffee shop were just friends and she did not know of her dating them. Brenda Porter stated that Debbie Miller did most of her drinking at Kosta's or Jimmy's and usually went by herself.

She stated that she stayed over at Debbie's apartment at night and there was no problems at the apartment when she stayed there with Debbie. She stated that Debbie always kept her door locked. She advised that Debbie had a roommate by the name of Debbie Borras; however, she does not live there anymore.

** WILLIAM RUSSELL MILLER **

William Russell Miller is Debbie Miller's brother. He spoke of Debbie going with Nick, whose dad owns the Continental Lounge. He stated that Debbie also ran around with a girl by the name of Brenda.

William Miller stopped at Debbie's apartment at approximately 11:30 p.m. on April 28, 1981, with his friend, Ted Thompson. They knocked on the door; however, there was no answer. He stated that Debbie usually left a key under the mat but it was not there. They then left the apartment building.

** JACKIE S. BOUDINOT **

Jackie Boudinot also works at Mr. T's Restaurant from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Jackie stated it was approximately 10:30 p.m. when Debbie left Mr. T's Restaurant on April 28, 1981 and she left alone. She stated that Debbie returned to the restaurant approximately 2:00 a.m. on April 29, 1981 and remained there for approximately 5 minutes. When she left the restaurant, she left with someone whom she does not know. He was tall, had dark curly hair and was wearing a blue jean jacket and a plaid shirt.

She stated that Debbie talked to a guy by the name of "Jeff" but she does not know his last name; however, she knows him from coming into Mr. T's Restaurant.

Jackie stated when Debbie left the restaurant she was wearing blue jeans and a white top with a flower design.



** FRANCIS HARVEY HILL, JR. **

Francis Hill also works at Mr. T's Restaurant from midnight to 7:00 a.m. The last time he saw Debbie Miller was 2:30 a.m. - 3:00 a.m. on April 29, 1981 at Mr. T's Restaurant. He stated that Debbie Miller was in the company of approximately four other people when she entered the restaurant; the only person he knew was "Jeff".

He stated that Debbie did not appear to be intoxicated and she did not appear to be having any type of arguments with any of the subjects.

He stated he never had any trouble with Debbie and they had a good working relationship. He did not notice her leave the restaurant that night as he was busy.

Francis Hill knows the subject by the name of "Harry" as he comes into Mr. T's Restaurant in the afternoon.

He has no knowledge of who killed Debbie Miller.

** HARRY A. DAVIS **

Harry Davis stated he went to Debbie Miller's apartment at approximately 11:30 p.m. on April 28, 1981 to visit with her after having had a fight with his wife. This was not the first time he has been to her apartment. When he arrived at her apartment, Debbie let him in and they had small talk conversation.

Harry Davis also stated he had intercourse with Debbie Miller one time in the bedroom and left the apartment at approximately 3:20 a.m. on April 29, 1981, enroute to his place of employment in Wooster, Ohio. He stated when he left her apartment, Debbie was wearing only her underpants.

He stated that while he was at her apartment, they heard a knock on the door; it was Debbie's brother and one of his friends. They did not answer the door, so they left.

** LINDA RIGSBY **

Linda Rigsby worked at Mr. T's Restaurant with Debbie Miller. She also lived in the apartment complex in front of Debbie Miller's building. She stated that she talked to Debbie on the night of April 28, 1981 at Mr. T's Restaurant. They talked about one of Debbie's boyfriends, Nick. Linda stayed at Mr. T's Restaurant for approximately 45 minutes talking to Debbie.

Linda stated that Debbie told her she was going straight home after she finished working. She stated Debbie was going to come to her apartment after getting off work; she made it plain to Linda that she was not going out that particular night.



Linda stated they had a "signal" system so they knew when each other were home. Linda went away to visit some relatives and upon returning to her apartment, she looked over to Debbie's apartment and saw there was no light on. She thought that Debbie had decided to go downtown after all.

Linda stayed awake until 4:00 a.m. on April 29, 1981. Around 2:30 a.m. she heard a knock on her door; however, when she went to the back door she did not see anyone.

Linda stated she knew Harry but did not know his last name. She knows that Debbie went out with him a couple of times and that he passed out on Debbie's couch. She also knows Harry drives a red car. She stated she knows of one other boyfriend of Debbie Miller's but does not know his name other than "Roger".

Linda stated that if anyone knocked on Debbie's door she would always ask who it was before opening the door.

** HAROLD B. CLINE **

Harold Cline stated he was looking at property to buy with Paul Hoffman and Larry Frankhauser and they found the victim. They had no idea who the victim was.

** DOUGLAS SHOUP **

Douglas Shoup stated he had conversation with Mark Melton the night before the homicide. Mark had stated to him that a homicide was going to occur at 151 West Third Street and he knew who was going to commit this crime.

Douglas Shoup stated he does not believe Mark Melton was involved and thinks he was just talking.

** SCOTT VANHESTEREN **

Scott VanHesteren stated he knew Debbie Miller. He also stated he went to school with Harry Davis. He stated that Harry Davis told him that he was with Debbie the night she was murdered and that he had been going with her for approximately three to four months.

** PAUL HOFFMAN **

Paul Hoffman stated he found the victim while showing property in the company of Larry Frankhauser and Harold Cline.



** CARLA KISER **

Carla Kiser stated she knows Debbie Miller and Harry Davis and saw them talking at Mr. T's Restaurant on April 28, 1981 at approximately 8:30 to 9:00 p.m. Carla did not observe or hear any trouble between the two of them. Carla stated she left Mr. T's Restaurant prior to them leaving.

** DORIS L. EVERLY **

Doris Everly stated that on the night of the homicide, she heard a "thump" around 2:00 or 3:00 a.m. She stated she left her apartment at approximately 7:00 a.m. on April 29, 1981, and observed a white male subject when exitting her apartment enroute for the Mall. When she returned home, she learned of the homicide. Doris Everly cannot describe the male subject she observed in the hallway of the apartment building.

** ROBERT FOLEY **

Robert Foley stated he knew Debbie Miller and has been to her apartment approximately 3 to 4 times. He stated he wanted to take some nude photographs of Debbie but never did.

Robert stated he has known Debbie for approximately one year and met her at Mr. T's Restaurant.

** EAFROM CHEATMAN **

Eafrom Cheatman stated that on May 17, 1982, Tim Melton told him that he killed Debbie Miller; this was told to him at Eahram Brooks' house. Eafrom stated Tim Melton did not relate any details of the homicide. He stated that Tim Melton was drunk.

** JERRY STEWART **

Jerry Stewart stated he had intercourse with Debbie Miller on April 21, 1981, after meeting her at Kosta's. He stated he saw Debbie once after that at Kosta's.



<u> SYNOPSIS</u>

On Wednesday, April 29, 1981, at approximately 1045 hours, I was dispatched to 151 West Third Street, Apartment #1 reference a possible homicide.

Upon my arrival at the above location, I observed a white female completely nude, laying on her back in a doorway between the kitchen and living room. This female was identified as Debra Lee Miller, white female, 18 years of age, date of birth: 05/14/62, social security number:

of 151 West Third Street. She had a considerable amount of blood, along with several deep lacerations, about the facial area. Two belts were wrapped around her right wrist. There was also a considerable amount of blood on the rest of her body and it appeared that someone tried to wipe the blood from her body with a rag or tissue, leaving blood smears in a swirl-like manner. Blood was also found in the living room, bedroom and kitchen. Lying next to the body was found broken iron stove grates along with aluminum pots, which were covered with blood.

Pt1. Hurlow from the Crime Laboratory took charge of all evidence and processed the crime scene, along with Pt1. Blunk and two BCI agents. (See their reports for evidence and photographs.) The body of the victim was taken to the Hamilton County Coroner's Office, in Cincinnati, Ohio, for the post mortem examination.

Upon investigating the homicide, it was learned that Debra Miller left her place of employment, Mr. T's Restaurant, at approximately 11:00 p.m. on April 28, 1981, and advised her co-workers she was going directly home instead of going out drinking, as she usually did. Prior to leaving Mr. T's Restaurant, the victim ate mushrooms, a salad and a pizzaburger.

In talking with several people who knew Debra L. Miller and worked with her, all of them basically related the same story:

She did most of her drinking at Kosta's, the Olympic Lounge and Jimmy's on the Square. She had numerous male friends; however, they only knew of two steady boyfriends, Nicholas Ghessouras and Harry Davis. Statements were obtained from these two individuals.

(See their statements for further details)

On Wednesday, April 29, 1981, Harry Davis came to the Detective Bureau of the Mansfield Police Department in regards to Debbie Miller. He was interviewed and it was learned that he was with Debbie from approximately 11:30 p.m. on April 28th until 3:30 a.m. on April 29th. He then left for his place of employment at Dowell Chemical Company in Wooster, Ohio. Harry Davis advised he had intercourse with her and when he left her apartment, the only item of clothing she was wearing was her underpants. Harry Davis also stated that while he was at the victim's apartment, her brother and one of his friends knocked on the door; however, she did not answer the door. We checked with Dowell Chemical Company and learned that Harry Davis did report for work on time at 4:00 a.m. April 29, 1981.

Nicholas Ghessouras was also interviewed and he stated he was at Bowling Green State University at the time of this incident; however, we are unable to verify this statement.

All evidence relating to this case was transported to the FBI Laboratory in Washington, D.C. for analysis.

Known finger, tip and palm prints, along with known pubic, head and chest hair and blood samples were collected from several males and

sent to the FBI Laboratory for compairson with the evidence found at the scene. (See FBI Laboratory Reports for their findings)

Dr. Milton Oakes, Richland County Coroner, placed the time of death at approximately 2:30 a.m., April 29, 1981, as determined by a rectal thermometer reading and temperature of the body at the time she was found. Dr. Paul Jolly, Chief Deputy Coroner, Hamilton County, places the time of death two hours after the victim consumed the mushrooms. The cause of death of Debra L. Miller is multiple blunt injuries of the head and neck.

James Vanest, Robert Lemon, Roger Heston, Nicholas Gesauras, Steven Medrano, Robert Foley, Jerry Stewart, Harry Davis, John Hurlow, and the stain on Larry Caudill's jeans are excluded as donors of these DNA profiles.

The STR DNA profiles recovered from small brownish colored stains on the sheet (Item #7) and a second area of the pot (Item #28) are not suitable for comparison due to low levels of DNA.

The Y-STR profile from the vaginal smear slides (items #24.1 & #40) Indicates the presence of a DNA mixture of at least three individuals that is not suitable for comparison due to no discernible major/minor profiles.

Remarks:

The remaining portions of Items #7, #24 through #26, #28 through #32, #34, #35, and #37 through #40 have been returned to Property Control and the extracted stain cuttings were retained by the laboratory. The vaginal smear slide in #40 was repackaged with Item #24 after analysis.

The DNA extracts from Items #7, #24 & #40 combined, #28 (three areas), #30, #31 (three areas), #32, #34, #35, and #39 were consumed by the laboratory during analysis. The DNA extracts from Items #26, #28 (one area), #29, #37, and #38 were retained by the laboratory.

Laboratory Examination:

Blood was indicated on Item #15, however human blood was not confirmed to preserve limited sample. Additional reddish stains are present on Item #15 and were not tested at this time.

STR DNA profiling using the polymerase chain reaction with the Promega PowerPlex® Fusion 6C kit was performed on Items #15 (three stains) and #27 (three areas). DNA profiling was successful at 2 loci on Item #15 (stain 2), 10 loci on Item #15 (stain 3), 7 loci on Item #15 (stain 4), 7 loci on Item #27 (area 27.1), 18 loci on Item #27 (area 27.2), and 17 loci on Item #27 (area 27.3).

Y-STR DNA profiling using the polymerase chain reaction with the Promega PowerPlex® Y 23 kit was performed on Items #27 (five areas), #33, and #36. Y-STR DNA profiling was successful at 13 loci on Item #33, 6 loci on Item #27 (area 27.1A), 3 loci on Item #27 (area 27.4), 5 loci on Item #27 (area 27.5), 9 loci on Item #27 (area 27.6), 4 loci on Item #27 (area 27.7), and 9 loci on Item #36.

Conclusions:

The Y-STR profile from the gauze from the "LR wail north of door facing east" (Item #33) indicates the presence of a DNA mixture of at least three male individuals with a major male DNA profile. The minor DNA profiles are not suitable for comparison due to the number of contributors.

James Vanest cannot be excluded as a donor of the major Y-STR profile. The probability that a randomly selected individual would be included as a possible contributor to this haplotype is 1 in 6,157. The Y-STR haplotype is expected to be the same for male individuals of the same paternal lineage.

The Y-STR profile from the gauze from the "L.R. by heater" (Item #36) indicates the presence of a DNA mixture of two male individuals.

John Hurlow cannot be excluded as a contributor. A statistical estimate of match rarity can be calculated upon request.

James Vanest cannot be excluded as a donor of the Y-STR profile foreign to John Hurlow. The probability that a randomly selected individual would be included as a possible contributor to this haplotype is 1 in 92. The Y-STR haplotype is expected to be the same for male individuals of the same paternal lineage.

The Y-STR profile from the pan (Item #27 area 1B resampling) indicates the presence of a male DNA profile.

James Vanest cannot be excluded as a donor of the Y-STR profile. The probability that a randomly selected individual would be included as a possible contributor to this haplotype is 1 in 1,559. The Y-STR haplotype is expected to be the same for male individuals of the same paternal lineage.

The Y-STR profile from the pan (Item #27 area 27.4) Indicates the presence of a male DNA profile.

James Vanest cannot be excluded as a donor of the Y-STR profile. The probability that a randomly selected individual would be included as a possible contributor to this haplotype is 1 in 27. The Y-STR haplotype is expected to be the same for male individuals of the same paternal lineage.

The Y-STR profile from the pan (Item #27 area 27.6) indicates the presence of a male DNA profile,

James Vanest cannot be excluded as a donor of the Y-STR profile. The probability that a randomly selected individual would be included as a possible contributor to this haplotype is 1 in 6,157. The Y-STR haplotype is expected to be the same for male individuals of the same paternal lineage.

The Y-STR profile from the pan (Item #27 area 27.7) indicates the presence of a male DNA profile.

James Vanest cannot be excluded as a donor of the Y-STR profile. The probability that a randomly selected individual would be included as a possible contributor to this haplotype is 1 in 46. The Y-STR haplotype is expected to be the same for male individuals of the same paternal lineage.

The Y-STR profile from the pan (Item #27 area 27.5) indicates the presence of a DNA mixture of at least two male individuals and is not suitable for comparison due to no discernible major/minor DNA profiles.

The STR DNA profile from the coral/white hand towel (Item #15 stain 2) indicates the presence of a partial DNA profile that is not suitable for comparison due to low levels of DNA and limited genetic information.

The STR DNA profile from the coral/white hand towel (Item #15 stain 3) indicates the presence of a DNA mixture of two individuals.

Debbie Miller cannot be excluded as a contributor to this DNA mixture.

James Vanest cannot be excluded as a donor of the male DNA profile. The probability that a randomly selected individual would be included as a possible donor of this male DNA profile at the loci available for statistical calculation is: 1 in 2.881.

The STR DNA profiles from the coral/white hand towel (Item #15 stain 4) and three areas of the pan (Item #27 areas 1B, 2B, & inside bottom) indicate the presence of a female DNA profile.

John Hurlow is excluded as a donor/contributor to the DNA profiles deemed sultable for comparison recovered from the gauze from the "LR wall north of door facing east" (Item #33), pan (Item #27), and the coral/white hand towel (Item #15).

Statistical estimates of match rarity for Debble Miller can be calculated upon request.

The DNA extracts from Items #15 (three stains), #27 (areas 27.1, 27.1A, 27.4, 27.5, 27.6, & 27.7), #33, and #36 were consumed during analysis.
