PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF STATE PRINTING.

DEAR SIR:—Please find enclosed herewith form of notice of receipt of proposals for state printing for the period of two years from November 1, 1928, as requested in your communication of recent date. This notice is required to be published in two or more newspapers printed in the city of Columbus and in two newspapers in each of the cities of Cleveland and Cincinnati. The publication of said notice in each of said newspapers should be for at least thirty full days prior to the expiration of the time fixed in said notice for receiving said proposals.

Under the provisions of Section 758, General Code, your department is required to open the proposals received within two days after the expiration of the time fixed for receiving the same. Awards for executing the first, second and fourth classes of printing provided for in Section 754, General Code, must, under the provisions of Section 763, General Code, be made to contractors executing such printing within the city of Columbus.
