**Narrative:**

On February 16, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Matthew Armstrong (Armstrong) began compiling and reviewing background information on Bryan Bailey Jr. (Bailey), a subject involved in the October 18, 2022, officer-involved critical incident at Southwest General Medical Center. The information included researching and reviewing past police reports involving the subject, a computerized criminal history (CCH), court records (if applicable), open/closed-source database inquiries and social media posts. The information gathered was obtained from the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit, the Southwest General Police Department (SGPD), and the Strongsville Police Department (SPD).

SA Armstrong reviewed the information and noted the following:

Computerized Criminal History:

Prior Law Enforcement Encounters:

SA Armstrong requested SGPD provide details regarding all previous encounters the agencies had with Bailey. Chief Tristan Harker provided five police reports detailing encounters the agency had with Bailey on three previous dates. Each encounter occurred while Bailey was a patient in the Emergency Department. None of the encounters involved Sgt. [REDACTED] Officer [REDACTED] or Officer [REDACTED]

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The Strongsville Police Department completed a query and indicated they had 8 previous encounters with Bailey not including the incident on October 18, 2022. Four CAD reports and four police department incident reports were provided and have been attached to this report.

A review of the reports revealed Bailey first had contact with the Strongsville Police Department in 2009. The following three contacts appeared relevant to this investigation as they outlined a pattern of mental health concerns.

This incident occurred on October 30, 2019. The call was for an attempted suicide. The report detailed the following:

On October 30, 2019, I responded to 16749 Whitney Rd for a report of attempted suicide. The original call was as follows:

COMP STATES SOMEONE IS TRYING TO KILL THEMSELVES  
 THERE IS A ALOT OF NOISE IN THE BACKGROUND  
 COMP STATED THERE IS A KNIFE BUT SHE IS IN THE OTHER ROOM  
 THE PERSON W/ THE KNIFE IS IN THE KITCHEN  
 2ND COMP STATED DID CUT HIMSELF W/ THE KNIFE  
 HE CUT HIMSELF IN THE FOREARM

When officers arrived, they located Bailey outside with a towel wrapped around his left forearm. Bailey indicated he wasn't going to hurt anyone except for himself. After Bailey was transported to the hospital Officers learned he had an argument with his sister and locked himself in the bathroom. His sister became afraid that Bailey might hurt himself and knocked on the door. Bailey then kicked open the door, grabbed a knife and cut himself below his left elbow.

On October 30, 2019, I responded to 16749 Whitney Rd for a report of attempted suicide. The original call was as follows:

COMP STATES SOMEONE IS TRYING TO KILL THEMSELVES  
THERE IS A ALOT OF NOISE IN THE BACKGROUND  
COMP STATED THERE IS A KNIFE BUT SHE IS IN THE OTHER ROOM  
THE PERSON W/ THE KNIFE IS IN THE KITCHEN  
2ND COMP STATED DID CUT HIMSELF W/ THE KNIFE  
HE CUT HIMSELF IN THE FOREARM

Upon arrival, I retrieved the medical/first aid kit from the trunk of my patrol car and entered through the front door to the residence, leaving the kit at the door. Once inside, there were several family members in the living room and I could see a large amount of blood on the floor in the kitchen. When asked where the subject was located, they all said that he was outside at the rear of the driveway waiting for the paramedics and they were not sure if he still had the knife with him. I then went through the kitchen and out the back door following a trail of blood on the floor and walls. Once outside, I could see the subject, later identified as Bryan Bailey (VIC), standing in the driveway with a towel wrapped around his left forearm. I asked Bryan if he had the knife with him, to which he replied, "No, and I'm not going to hurt anyone but myself". I then checked Bryan for weapons and found none. At that time, I indicated to dispatch that it was safe for SFD to enter the scene. I then asked Bryan to sit on the driveway while I retrieved my medical kit from the front door. I returned and applied a tourniquet on Bryan's left bicep at 0921 and relayed that information to dispatch to note the time. SFD then walked Bryan to their ambulance before transporting him to SWGH. I received a replacement tourniquet from SFD and placed that in my medical kit.

I returned to the residence where I received information about Bryan and the incident. According to the other family members present, Bryan had been out with friends last night and they believe he was drinking. Bryan then got into an argument with his sister and locked himself in the bathroom. Afraid that he might hurt himself, the sister began knocking on the bathroom door. Brian then kicked open the bathroom door, grabbed a knife from the kitchen, and cut himself just below his left elbow.

On Saturday December 24, 2011 at 0156 hrs I (Ptl. J. Steving #7160) stopped a red Saturn 4 door Ohio registration FCL 1045 on Pamela Drive near Fair Road after observing several moving violations. I first observed the vehicle turn onto Whitney Road westbound from Pearl Road northbound and drift over the center line after turning. I accelerated to catch up to the vehicle and the driver hit their brakes at the stop sign of the intersection of Whitney Road and Big Creek Parkway and continued on without stopping completely. I accelerated again and caught up to the vehicle near the next stop sign on Eastland at Fair Road. The driver slowed to a stop and turned right, failing to use its right turn signal. After the vehicle turned, the vehicle drifted over the center line with the driver's side tires and corrected back to its lane. The driver then activated its left turn signal and turned left onto the next

street, Pamela Drive. At this time I activated my overhead lights to initiate a traffic stop of the vehicle.

After stopping, I approached on the driver's side and greeted the driver. I requested the driver's license and proof of insurance. The driver, identified as Misty Rhea, stated that she had her temps but did not have them on her. I asked her for her information and she provided it to me. As I spoke to her I detected the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle and saw that her eyes were glassy. Ms. Rhea stated that she was using her boyfriend's car and headed over to pick him up from work. She stated that she was having a bad day and had gotten into a physical fight with her mother in Cleveland and was "ran over" by her mother. I asked her if she reported it to Cleveland police and she stated that "nothing would be done." I asked her where her boyfriend's work was. She stated Applebee's Strongsville. She then stated that she was taking Prospect over to pick him up. I asked her who the passenger was. She stated a friend of hers. I asked him for his ID card. He produced an Ohio ID card identifying himself as Bryan Bailey. I advised them to stay in the car and returned to my car to check their status' and advise dispatch. I verified with my MDC that Bryan only had an ID card and Ms. Rhea did only have her temporary permit and was only 19 years of age.

Ptl. Bathgate (7107) was on scene as I approached the driver's side again. I returned Mr. Bailey's ID card and requested that Ms. Rhea exit the vehicle. She complied and I escorted her to the front of my patrol car. I asked her where she was headed again. She stated that she was going to Applebee's Strongsville to pick up her boyfriend, the owner of the vehicle. She stated that she was going to take Prospect. I then asked her where she was headed on Pamela because it was a dead end. She stated that she knew I was going to pull her over. I asked Ms. Rhea how much alcohol she had to drink tonight. She stated "none." I asked her if her friend in the car had any and she stated "no." I advised her that I was going to have her perform some fiend sobriety tests (SFSTs).

I first checked her eyes for horizontal gaze nystagmus (HGN). On the HGN her eyes displayed 6 of 6 clues, a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, and an onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. Her eyes were also glassy and she swayed from right to left when I checked. After the HGN, I explained the one leg stand (OLS) test instructions. Ms. Rhea advised me prior to the test that she had back problems. She proceeded to start the test and counted to 2 with her arms out away from her body before putting her foot down and requesting to take her boots off because they had heels. I advised her that she could and she opted to. She then began the test again and used her arms for balance, reaching the number 20 on a 30 second test. After the OLS, I explained the instructions for the walk and turn test (WAT). On the WAT she failed to touch heel to toe on steps 2 through 9 on the way down the line, turned incorrectly on spinning around on both feet, and stepped off the line on step 3 on the way down. On the way back she failed to touch heel to toe on steps 2 through 5 and 6 through 9. She also stepped off the line on the second step back down the line. After the WAT I requested a sample of her breath into portable breath tester (PBT) #24 and she complied. Ms. Rhea registered a .153 BAC. At this time I placed her under arrest for OVI and handcuffed her. I asked her if there was anything in the car she wanted me to grab. She stated her cell phone and purse. I secured her in the back seat of my patrol car and spoke with Mr. Bailey. I requested that he exit the vehicle. He slowly exited the vehicle and I asked him if there was anything illegal in the car. He stated that there was not. I walked around to the driver's side and on the driver's seat right next to Ms. Rhea's phone was a glass multicolored pipe containing burnt marijuana residue. I then retrieved her purse and phone and observed there to be a small bag of suspected marijuana under the passenger seat, next to a lighter, and part of silver in color grinder containing suspected marijuana. The other half of that was in the passenger side door pocket. I also located another glass multicolored pipe containing burnt marijuana residue inside the glove box.

Ms. Rhea stated that she "doesn't do drugs" and did not notice that pipe sitting on the driver's seat under her back side. She stated that she did not know if the other stuff was Bryan's. I secured the vehicle and left it on Pamela Drive. Ptl. Bathgate transported Mr. Bailey back to SPD to be cited for marijuana possession and drug paraphernalia possession. He was released to a sober party. Mr. Bailey is ordered to appear in Strongsville Mayor's Court on January 5, 2012 at 1000 hrs.

During booking Ms. Rhea was cooperative. When we arrived on station I asked Ms. Rhea to take anything she had in her pockets out, and she stated that only thing she had was an Excedrin pill bottle "for her back pain." I opened it up to check it and it was filled with a very small amount of green leafy substance that tested positive for marijuana. Ms. Rhea stated that she "didn't know that marijuana was in there" because "I don't do drugs." She stated that Bryan gave that pill bottle to her. I advised her that she was going to be charged with the possession.

he stated during the interview that she had "two Bud Lights with my mom" earlier in the evening around 6p. She stated that she finished drinking "about 8 or 9." She stated that she did not feel that she was under the influence of an alcoholic beverage at the time. Ms. Rhea submitted a sample of her breath into the Intoxilyzer 8000 machine and registered a .154 BAC. She was cited for OVI, BAC, marked lanes violation, driving on a temporary permit, drug possession and paraphernalia. Ms. Rhea is ordered to appear in Strongsville Mayor's Court on December 28, 2011 at 0830 hrs. The evidence was entered and photographed by Ptl. Glover (7180). Booking tape #91 and disc #16 were entered into evidence as well.

Dispatch received a call stating that Bryan Bailey was hit in the head with a baseball bat by a group of black males. Upon my arrival I saw Bryan sitting on the ground with a towel on his head. A female, Glenda Thomas, approached me and stated that she saw the black males get into a green Ford Taurus and gave me a plate of EWZ 9530, which was later discovered to be EWZ 5930 and came back to Trashawna Grissom. I immediately gave that information over the radio while I started getting statements.

I spoke with Jacob Martin, Tom Morgan and Brent Kannel who are friends of Bryan and they witnessed the incident. Jacob wrote a quick statement and it did not provide any helpful information, but he was in a hurry and had to leave. Brent stated that 4 black males and a female came around the corner of the building, and hit Bryan in the head with a bat. He explained that they ran into a green Ford Taurus and left the scene. Brent does not know who hit Bryan, but stated that the subject did not have a shirt on at the time.

Tom stated that Stefan, Derrick Hudson, Paco (Richard Miller) and an unknown male as well as a female came around the side of the apartment building and hit Bryan in the head. He described Derrick as a black male with a buzz cut; Stefan as a black male, approximately 5'9"; Paco as a black male with a tattoo on his chest; a heavyset female and another black male with a hat. Tom explained they had a blue bat, but he could not identify which one actually struck Bryan. He did state that Bryan's girlfriend was messing around with Stefan, but doesn't believe there were any confrontations between the two males. On a separate but possibly related incident, Tom believes that the same group of black males were at his residence at 0200 hrs on July 16. He explained that they were knocking on the windows of his apartment trying to get him to fight and they eventually left. Several minutes later he heard loud noises outside and saw that the windows in his red Pontiac Grand Am had been smashed out. Tom didn't see them actually smash the windows but explained that he is sure it was them.

While I was at Cherry Tree, Ptl. Pientka located the green Taurus, stopped it and identified that the occupants were the ones involved in the felonious assault at Cherry Tree. After searching the area, two baseball bats, a partially filled 40 oz bottle of beer and a pair of blue basketball shorts were found by Ptl. Siwick behind the Salvation Army. Ptl. Pientka included a supplement to the report. The four males and female were transported back to station and the green Taurus was towed away by Center. The three adults were identified as Antonio Davis, Stefan Hampton, and Trashawna Grissom. The two juveniles males are Derrick Hudson and Richard Miller. Ptl. Bertz responded to Southwest General to get pictures of the victim. The pictures have been added to the server along with the pictures on scene and at the Salvation Army.

Another witness, Lynn Lenz, stated that she was driving with her husband down WB on Whitney toward US 42. She identified 4-6 males walking through the Lowe's parking lot with baseball bats. She stated that she pulled into GFS and observed a green Taurus come to a "speedy stop" and 4-5 males got out of the car and ran behind Rick Yusi. Lynn explained that she observed the black males running toward Wal-Mart and then police were on scene. She stated that the bats were found behind the Salvation Army and they are the same bats that she saw the black males holding at Lowe's. Lynn is not included in the names portion of the report because she wishes to remain anonymous because she fears retaliation if the subjects find out she gave us information. Her statement is included in the case jacket.

Upon arrival back to station, Detectives Dzurisin and Nettles informed me that they were going to interview all of the subjects and collect statements. Antonio completed a statement and explained that he and the rest of the males went over to Cherry Tree because Richard, Derrick and Stefan wanted to confront some individuals about threatening phone calls. Antonio stated that Derrick was arguing with a male, then another male, Bryan, came over and punched Derrick. Antonio explained that Richard approached Bryan and hit him in the head with a baseball bat.

Trashawna completed a statement and explained that someone hit her brother, Derrick, in the face and someone else started throwing weights at her and her friends. She then noticed Bryan sitting on the ground,

but didn't know what had happened. Trashawna stated that they all got in the vehicle and drove away.

Richard refused to complete a statement but spoke with Det. Nettles about the incident. Richard stated that they went over to Cherry Tree to buy marijuana. He stated that everyone knew what was going on except for Antonio. When they arrived there were 7 males standing with their shirts off and an argument eventually started. Richard stated that Derrick was punched by a male, so he punched that male in the head. Later Richard stated he doesn't know what object he used to hit the male with.

Derrick Hudson spoke with Det. Nettles and stated that he went to Cherry Tree for a drug deal and when they arrived there were 7 males with their shirts off. Derrick stated that the one male opened his car trunk and pulled out some weights and began to throw them at him and his friends. He explained that there was an argument and Derrick was punched in the face by Bryan. Derrick stated that he fell down and when he got up he saw Bryan on the ground. He did not witness Richard hit Bryan with a bat.

The three adults and two juveniles were placed under arrest for Felonious Assault. Based on statements, Antonio was unaware what was going on and just happened to be there. Antonio stated and Richard admitted to hitting Bryan, but Richard stated he doesn't know what he hit him with. The witness, Lynn, stated that she saw the group walking from Lowe's with bats, so it appears the group was heading there prepared to fight.

On July 17 at 0430 hrs. I received a call from Juvenile Court stating that they will take Derrick Hudson and Richard Miller in their detention facility. Myself and Ptl. Bartlett transported them to DH and I was given summons to issue to their parents which were passed on to dayshift.

The baseball bats, shorts and a beer bottle were entered into evidence. A narrative written by Det. Dzurisin is included in the case jacket.

ON 07/16/2010 I RESPONDED TO SOUTHWEST GENERAL HOSPITAL (SWG H) TO TAKE PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE VICTIM, BRIAN BAILEY. UPON MY ARRIVAL AT SWGH MR. BAILEY'S FOREHEAD WAS BEING STITCHED UP BY A DOCTOR. AFTER HE WAS FINISHED I TOOK PHOTOGRAPHS OF HIS VISIBLE INJURIES. MR. BAILEY HAD A LACERATION ACROSS HIS FOREHEAD JUST BELOW HIS HAIRLINE APPROXIMATELY 5 INCHES LONG. HE ALSO HAD A BLACK LEFT EYE AND A SWOLLEN LIP. WHILE I WAS AT SWGH MR. BAILEY THREW UP BLOOD APPROXIMATELY 5 TIMES IN ABOUT A 5 MINUTE SPAN. MR. BAILEY STATED THAT HE WAS UNSURE IF HE WAS HIT IN THE STOMACH.

AFTER HE WAS FINISHED SPITTING UP BLOOD I ASKED MR. BAILEY ABOUT THE INCIDENT. MR. BAILEY STATED THAT HE SAW APPROXIMATELY 4-5 MALES STANDING BESIDE ONE OF THE BUILDINGS AT CHERRY TREE. MR. BAILEY STATED THAT HE HEARD THE MALES TALKING ABOUT A CAR AND THEN THEY APPROACHED HIM AND ONE OF THEM HIT HIM WITH A BASEBALL BAT. MR. BAILEY SAID HE DID NOT LOSE CONSCIOUSNESS DURING THE ASSAULT AND THAT, ALTHOUGH HE GOT A GOOD LOOK AT THE MALES, HE DID NOT KNOW WHO THEY WERE. THE PHOTOS WERE DOWNLOADED ONTO THE SPD SERVER.

ON (FRI) 07-10-2010 I (PTL PIENKA) RESPONDED WITH THE OTHER UNITS TO CHERRY TREE APARTMENT. JUST PRIOR TO ARRIVAL, DISPATCHED ADVISED THE SUSPECTS (BLACK MALES) WERE RUNNING BEHIND THE "GFS" STORE. I DROVE INTO THE "LOEW'S" LOT AND DID NOT LOCATE THE SUSPECTS IN THE AREA. I THEN PROCEEDED TO PEARL RD. I DROVE NORTH AND STARTED TO ENTER THE "WAL MART" LOT WHERE I OBSERVED THE SUSPECT VEHICLE (GREEN FORD TAURUS WITH REG EWZ5930) ATTEMPTING TO PULL ONTO PEARL RD. I ACTIVATED MY OVERHEADS AND PULLED IN FRONT OF THE VEHICLE IN ORDER TO STOP IT FROM EXITING. THERE WAS A FEMALE DRIVER, A MALE PASSANGER AND THREE MALES IN THE REAR. I ASKED FOR IDENTIFICATION AND THE MALE SAID THEY HAD NONE. BUT THE FEMALE GAVE HER DRIVERS LICENSE. ALL DENIED BEING AT CHERRY TREE AND DENIED ANY INVOLVEMENT. THEY BEGAN YELLING AND ACTING BELIGERENT. THEY WERE SAYING THAT THE ONLY REASON THEY WERE BEING STOPPED IS BECAUSE THE WERE BLACK. ALL WERE HANDCUFFED AND EVENTUALLY IDENTIFIED.

On 07/17/10 at 1419 hours, I, Ptl. Cousino 7175, was dispatched to 9415 Cherry Tree Drive for a report of a tire iron found in the tree lawn. Upon my arrival, I spoke to Thomas Morgan (WIT) who stated he found a tire iron in the grass. The tire iron was in the grass on the south east side of the entrance door to 9415 Cherry Tree. Mr. Morgan stated the ARA's involved in the assault yesterday ran through the grass in the area where he found the tire iron today. Mr. Morgan stated he observed the ARA's had two (2) baseball bats, but did not see anyone with a tire iron yesterday. Mr. Morgan's statement is included in the case jacket. The tire iron was entered into evidence. Refer to CAD 10-21930.

On 07162010 I, Ptl. Siwik, assisted Ptl. Kubacki on a felonious assault call. The suspects were apprehended in the exit drive from wal-mart / salvation army. A witness stated that the males ran behind a neighboring auto repair shop carrying baseball bats. I followed the tracks that they left in the tall grass. It appeared to be 3-4 sets of tracks. The tracks led me to the rear of the salvation army. Two baseball bats were located in a box at the rear door of the salvation army. I notified Det. Dzurisin and he photographed the bats and gathered them as evidence. He also collected a pair of basketball shorts from the box.

While speaking with Kannel, he stated that he was drinking in the garage at 16751 with some friends. He said that an altercation broke out and he was hit with a beer bottle and punched in the face. Kannel said that Bryan Bailey hit him on the left side of his face with a beer bottle, and Bobby Dickens punched him in the face. Kannel stated something about it supposedly being an accident, but he then stated that he wanted to press charges.

Kannel and his grandmother pointed out that he already had damage to his nose from a prior fight with his father (one week earlier). Kannel had a broken nose and numerous stitches under his nose from that fight. During tonight's altercation, when he was punched in the nose, the prior stitches popped out and more damage was done to the already broken nose.

At that point Kannel went with the firefighters/paramedics to be checked out. He eventually would refuse to be transported, but said that he would have his grandmother take him.

Pictures of Kannel's injuries were taken inside of the squad. Those pictures were downloaded to the 2009 file folder.

After speaking with Kannel I responded to 16751 Whitney to speak with Bailey who was being detained by Officer Strong. Upon my arrival at 16751 I spoke with Bailey who admitted to hitting Kannel in the face. He stated that he was originally in an argument with a Chris Duncan. Bailey said that he attempted to hit Duncan with a beer bottle, but only partially hit him, so he then threw a punch that grazed Duncan, but connected with Kannel. Bailey said that he never meant to hit Kannel, but that he did in fact hit him. Bailey said that he didn't hit Kannel real well, but due to his prior injuries it caused his nose to start bleeding badly.

I then went and spoke with a Michael Workman who lives next door to 16751. Workman stated that he heard the commotion from the fight and came outside. Workman stated that he yelled at the guys to cut it out and for Kannel to leave, which he was in the process of doing. Workman stated that as Kannel was walking back toward Cherry Tree apartments, he was yelling that he was going to come back with a guy and shoot all of them. Workman stated that he was concerned for the family. Workman also stated that after Kannel left the scene he walked to Workman's family's apartment in Cherry Tree at 9291 #102 where he caused another scene. Before leaving Workman wrote out a statement as to the events as he saw them.

After obtaining a written statement from Workman and a verbal statement from Bailey (he was very intoxicated and could barely speak), I went back to 9291 Cherry Tree. Upon my arrival there I met with Scott Wilson Sr, Bobby Dickens, and Scott Wilson Jr. Wilson Sr. stated that they were all home just hanging out when Kannel came walking up to their apartment bleeding and yelling something about getting back at their cousin. Wilson Sr. stated that Kannel was threatening them and spitting blood from his nose in their direction. While arguing with them, two females (Kannel's grandmother and girlfriend) walked over and tried to drag him home.

A lot of blood drops could be seen on the parking lot leading up to the apartment door, as well as the sidewalk and the actual patio of 9291 Cherry Tree #102. The glass slider leading into Unit 102 had blood on it from where Kannel spit on the window. Wilson Sr. stated that he led Dickens, Wilson Jr. and the rest of his family inside and closed the door, which caused Kannel to walk to his unit.

I then asked Dickens if he at any time was at the party at 16751, to which he replied no. I told him that Kannel stated that he was there and that he punched Kannel in the face a couple times. Dickens, Wilson Sr. and Wilson Jr. all stated that Dickens had been at 9291 Unit 102 the whole night and was not at the party. Dickens then showed me his knuckles and hands, which had no blood, cuts, or marks of any kind on them. Dickens, Wilson Sr., and Wilson Jr. then wrote out statements about the incident.

At that point I went to Southwest Hospital to speak with Kannel, who was not there. The nurses stated that no one by that name or that injury had been there yet. Kannel originally stated that he did not wish to go in the squad and that his grandmother would take him. It is unknown at this time what hospital he went to.

This report will be respectfully forwarded to the Prosecutor for a review of possible charges.
