This letter puts you on notice that the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation is in the process of obtaining the appropriate court orders or other documents necessary to obtain this data from you.

Section 3703(f) requires you to preserve this data for a period of 90 days, which can be extended for an additional 90 days upon renewal of this request. Please note that this letter does not require you to turn over the data to the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation now, it simply requires that you preserve the data until the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation returns with the appropriate legal authority.
