**Narrative:**

On Tuesday, May 20, 2025, at approximately 0312 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation Special Agent David Wieging (SA Wieging) interviewed Columbus Division of Police (CPD) Officer Duncan Thompson (Officer Thompson). The interview took place at CPD SWAT Headquarters. Prior to the interview, Officer Thompson was informed that his statement was voluntary and that he could stop answering SA Wieging's questions at any time. Officer Thompson agreed to speak with SA Wieging.

Officer Thompson was identified as being a police officer who witnessed and/or had some level of involvement in the May 19, 2025 officer-involved shooting which occurred in the area of 4482 Hampton Woods Court, Columbus, Ohio. Reportedly, Officer Thompson did not discharge a firearm during the course of the incident. The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information of the incident known or observed by this officer.

Officer Thompson explained he was at a substation with his probationary officer when Officer Harris gets on the air [radio] and communicated, they have been "shot at." When they arrived on scene, his probationary officer grabbed a shield while Officer Thompson grabbed a rifle out of their cruiser. They held the "line" until more officers arrived on scene. Officer Thompson stated he did not give any commands and heard another officer on scene say that "he (suspect) came to the door" and "he saw a gun."

Officer Thompson stated that prior to his arrival one shot by the suspect had already been fired, but there were shots fired by the suspect after his arrival, too. Officer Thomson subsequently said the suspect and woman inside the residence came to the door a couple of times and then he saw a muzzle flash from inside followed by tree leaves above him falling. No officers were hit. Officer Thompson remained on scene until SWAT arrived and took over.
