NARRATIVE

Westerville Officers were called to assist Blendon Twp. Police during a shots fired call. Officers arrived on scene and helped render aid to an unknown female suffering from a gunshot wound and remained on scene as scene security.

On 8/25/2023 at 18:29 Westerville Police dispatch aired a request for assistance / officer in trouble call from Blendon Twp. Police. in the area of the Kroger parking lot located at 5991 Sunbury Road. Dispatch advised that shots had been fired and had no further information.

I activated my overhead lights and sirens and responded from the area of Huber Village Park. I arrived on scene at 18:32. Upon arrival I found a Blendon Twp. officer rendering aid to a black female, approximately 20-25 years of age, lying her back near a black sedan that had crashed into the Kroger. I advised dispatch of this and requested that radio traffic be held. The female was suffering from what appeared to be a single gunshot wound to the left side of her chest. The female was unresponsive at the time of my arrival.

I had retrieved medical gear from my patrol vehicle and used it to render aid by placing a chest seal over the wound on the female's chest as CPR was continued by other officers. An unknown medical doctor was on scene assisting. The doctor suggested that a CPR mask be used in an attempt to give rescue breaths to the female. I retrieved a mask and attempted to give rescue breaths, but this was unsuccessful due to a large amount of fluid in the female's mouth. Ofc. Amos #588 and Ofc. Ferguson from Minerva Park Police had arrived on scene and we began taking turns rendering CPR to the female until paramedics arrived on scene to treat her.

I then remained in the area with Ofc. Schleve #559 at the request of a Blendon Twp. Lieutenant, who asked that we remain to assist with security of the scene. This request was approved by Sgt. Hill-Spann #560. I remained on scene to speak with an investigator with the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation about the incident and to help with scene security until approximately 00:13 on 8/25/2023.

All body worn and cruiser camera footage was submitted to evidence and a tag was created.

NARRATIVE

On 8/24/23 I was at Sunbury / County Line Rd when dispatch aired they received a call from Blendon Twp PD at 1829hrs about shots fired at Kroger 5991 Sunbury Rd, and asked Sgt. Hill-Spann to send officers. Sgt. Hill-Spann advised it was an officer in trouble, and yes, send officers. I responded in cruiser #3 with my lights and siren activated, and arrived at 1833hrs.

When I arrived on scene a Blendon Twp PD Sgt. was doing CPR on a female black laying on her back that appeared to be unresponsive, and an unknown male black was holding her head. After I put on gloves I replaced the Blendon Twp PD Sgt with CPR. As I was doing CPR I noticed a chest seal on her left breast area, and then was advised the male holding the female's head was a doctor. I later found out that Officer Ross placed the chest seal on the female. While I was doing CPR Officer Amos #588 arrived on scene, and I asked him to find out where the medics were at since they were not on scene yet. A Minerva Park Officer replaced me doing CPR, and I once again asked about medics. Radio advised the medics were not told the scene was clear and they were on their way in. Once medics arrived and transported I cleared from the scene.

NARRATIVE

On 8/24/2023 I was on patrol in Westerville PD cruiser 21 and I responded to an Officer in trouble call at 5991 Sunbury Rd. in Blendon Township. Dispatch advised that there were shots fired. Upon arrival there were other officers providing aid to the person that was shot.

I saw a Blendon Township officer with blood on his forearm. I asked him if he was okay and he was unsure if the blood was his. He said she tried to run him over. I told him not to say anything else and walked him away from where the officers were rendering aid. I requested a medic respond to check out the officer. A Franklin County deputy came over to us and advised he was going to take the officer back to Blendon's station. I advised them I would have a medic respond there. I updated dispatch on the location the medic was needed at.

The Blendon PD Sergeant advised the shooting took place closer to the front of the store by a handicap parking space. I began to walk that way and located the spent shell casing in the drive area. I advised the Sergeant and he got a traffic cone from a Blendon cruiser and placed it over the casing.

I then remained on scene for scene security along the outer perimeter near the gas station until I was cleared by the Blendon Township Lieutenant.

NARRATIVE

I responded to the Kroger at 5991 S. Sunbury Rd. when we received notice of "shots fired" at that location where a Blendon officer was working on a vehicle lockout.

Upon arrival I parked on the south side of the plaza to block vehicles from entering/exiting the parking lot. I spoke with a few people who had a video of the incident and/or witnessed the incident, and stood with them until a Franklin County Deputy met with them to gather their information. I then made contact with officers Ross #589 and Amos #588 who were actively performing life saving measures on the female who had been shot. They advised they didn't need relieved so I remained in the area for security purposes until the medics arrived.

Shortly after the medics arrived they asked for the handcuffs to be removed from the female which I took care of for them. This was the extent of my involvement.

NARRATIVE

On 8/24/2023 at 1829 hours WPD received an officer in trouble / shots fired call from Blendon Twp PD. The address of the call was Kroger, 5991 Sunbury Road. I authorized WPD units to respond to the scene. I also responded to the scene using lights and sirens. I was the last WPD unit to arrive on scene, and witnessed officers from Westerville and another police department providing life saving aid to a black female that appeared to be suffering from a gunshot wound. The female was laying outside of a vehicle that had crashed and was on the sidewalk against the Kroger building. Officers had already set up crime scene tape and were identifying witnesses. I assisted by moving cruisers out of the way to make room for WFD medics. After the female was taken from the scene by WFD, I received a request from Lt. Retherford from Blendon Township PD to keep two WPD officers at the scene to hold the perimeter. WPD Officers Schleve and Ross remained at the scene, while all other WPD officers cleared.
