Narrative:

On Tuesday, December 20, 2022, the Marion County Sheriff’s Office and Marion Police Department requested the assistance of the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) with the investigation of an Officer Involved Critical Incident which occurred in LaRue, Marion County, Ohio. During the investigation, Agents obtained records from the Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission (OPOTC) for ██████████ (██████████).

Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Scott Stranahan reviewed those records and learned the following.

██████████ attended the OPOTC basic training academy at the Marion Law Enforcement Academy from August 28, 2017 through May 3, 2018 (class # BAS14-065). Upon completion, ██████████ received an appointment (commission) with the Marion County Sheriff's Office.

██████████ worked in a Part-time status from June 4, 2018 through September 17, 2018. In September of 2018, ██████████'s status was changed to Full-time. ██████████ attended several "Advanced Training" classes between June 18, 2019 through November of 2019.
