On Friday, August 1, 2025, the investigation regarding the July 13, 2025, officer-involved critical incident that occurred in the city of Middletown, Butler County, Ohio, was presented to a Butler County Grand Jury by the Butler County Prosecutor, Michael T. Gmoser. After deliberating on all of the evidence and facts presented to it by the prosecutor, the Grand Jury returned NO INDICTMENT.

All evidence in this case has been returned to the Middletown Police Department. Special Agent Steven Seitzman and Special Agent Kevin Barbeau reviewed this investigation. The investigation was sufficiently pursued, and all investigative efforts and aspects of this case have been completed. The Middletown Police Department no longer requires the assistance of BCI with respect to this matter.
