On September 17, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Nick Valente (Valente) completed a review of the video captured from the body-worn camera (BWC) of during this incident.

Created three separate BWC videos relevant to this investigation and all three videos were reviewed as noted below.

Amped Replay was used to review the videos.

SA Valente made working copies of the three BWC videos and placed the copied videos in a folder on his BCI issued laptop. The working copies of the videos were used for the review.
