## **Summary**:

On 9/21/2023, Special Agent (SA) Ryan Scheiderer requested the assistance of the Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Cyber Crime Unit (CCU) in submitting a search warrant for the iCloud account "kiyayoung1@gmail.com" to Apple, and processing the data upon receiving it. SA Joseph Wilhelm submitted a search warrant to Apple on the same date.

### Details:

On 10/10/2023, upon receiving the response from Apple, SA Wilhelm downloaded the information provided by Apple for Ta'kiya Young's iCloud Account using the Magnet Apple Warrant Return Tool. The tool downloaded the data from Apple, verified the hashes of the downloaded files, decrypted the files, and constructed the data archive in the correct format to be parsed. SA Wilhelm parsed the data using Cellebrite and created a Cellebrite Reader Report.

#### Conclusions:

SA Wilhelm reviewed the data and found that no iMessages were saved on the iCloud Account. The iCloud Account did not have any device backups which could have contained any sms, mms, or iMessage content.

Allow a few seconds for the data to begin loading indicated by a green status bar in the bottom right corner. If the parsed data is not loaded automatically then click Open from the File menu, browse to this folder, and choose "Apple iCloud (Backup)\_2023-10-10\_Report.ufdr" to view the data that was processed.

NOTE: In Cellebrite Reader, some entries may be hidden based on the program's default behavior. Go to Tools -> Settings -> General Settings -> "Duplicate Rules" and choose either
